


Mecklenburg Co. NC Wills 4783-1844
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In the name of God, amen. I Joseph Kerr of the State of Carolina & County of Mecklenburg, Being in a weakly state of body, but sound of memory calling to remembrance the mortality of my body & approaching dissolution of it; Do think it convenient to constate this to be my last will & testament; And first I recommend my soul into the hand of God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the general resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God who gave it; and as to such temporal property as it has pleased the Lord to bless me with. I dispose of it in this following manner & form — I give & bequeath to my wife Elizabeth ~~Wife~~ Chargant her the whole of every kind of worldly property her estate as she may think proper — and I constitute and my beloved son William my wife before wife Chargant here do of this my last will & testament, to testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 18th day of June 1818 In presence of —

Do State of North Carolina } I, Joseph Kerr citizen of the County of Mecklenburg
doth declare & say } being in a low state of Health, but then the mind of Almighty God, & enjoy the full use of my reason & understanding con-
calling to mind the mortality of man. Do make this my last will & testa-
ment, as to the worldly goods in his possession has been pleased to bestow to me. I desire & implore God in his providence to an-
dise I leave to my beloved wife Elizabeth hereinafter mentioned during her

 of the said testimony I now leave annexed to me by Jacobus Wilson
 containing one hundred & Twenty acres including the mansion house &
 other improvements on said land & likewise Ninety nine acres con-
 veined to me by Jason Wilson joining the lands of Frederick Denting,
 Joshua Denting (now dead) & the above described one hundred &
 Twenty acres, also five Negroes viz two & his wife Hannah, Deer Nell,
 their wife Abby & their son Jacob, also three head of Horses to be chosen by
 her out of the stock on hand at the time of my decease, my riding horse
 & Harness, my Waggon & harness, the third part of my horses, cattle
 & the third part of all my stock of Hogs, ten head of Sheep & all the fowls
 on the plantation at my decease & likewise all my household &
 kitchen furniture or as much thereof as she may see fit to keep
 for her own use except two beds & furniture for my two youngest
 children herein after to be described, also my Silver Watch & Clerk of
 my Library of books as she may think proper to choose for her own
 library in two good places, two beds two horses & two Mallets & Log Cabin
 with as much provision as will be sufficient to support her & her
 family & Stock for one year whether gathered in or growing at the time
 of my decease as the case may be —

Secondly As to my son William Hendrie he has received his portion
 of Land & also one Negro man named Solomon which Negro he has now
 in his possession, I give said Negro to him & his Heirs forever

Thirdly I give & bequeath to my son John F Hendrie two hundred acres
 of Land wherein he now lies it being a part of a tract of Land
 purchased from F B Smart for which he has a bill in his possession
 also my Negro man Frank & Negro girl Dilsey which he has in his
 possession to him & his Heirs forever —

Fourthly I give & bequeath to my son James Hendrie my Negro boy
 Christopher to him & his Heirs forever, he has received his portion of
 land and disposed of the same before this —

Fifthly I give & bequeath to my son Ephraim Hendrie one hundred
 & fifty acres of Land wherein he now lies, joining my son John & his Negro
 land with my negro boys land, such who he has in his possession to
 him & his Heirs forever —

Sixthly I give & bequeath to my son Green Hendrie one hundred & three

In ~~the~~ Justice Dentins ~~have done of the best~~ I have bequeathed one hundred & twenty acres, also five Negroes, Big Ben & his wife Hannah, Deacon Ned & his wife Neddy & their son Jacob, also three head of Horses to be chosen by her out of the Stock on hand at the time of my death, my riding Horse & Harness, my Waggon & harness, the third part of my horned cattle, the third part of all my Stock of Hogs, ten head of Sheep & all the fowls on the plantation at my death & likewise all my Hens to add to her kitchen/pantry or as much thereof as she may see proper to keep for her own use except two hens & pullets for my two youngest children having first to be distributed, also my silver watch & clock & my Library of Books as she may think proper to choose for her own library two good plows, two bats two hoes & two Mattocks together with as much provision as will be sufficient to support her & her family & Stock for one year whether gathered in or growing at the time of my decease as the case may be —

Secondly As to my son William Hendrie he has received his portion of Land & also one Negro man named Solomon which Negro he has now in his possession, I give said Negro to him & his Heirs forever.

Thirdly I give & bequeath to my son John Hendrie two hundred acres of Land whereon he now lives it being a part of a tract of Land I purchased from FB Smart for which he has a bill in his possession also my negro man Frank & negro girl Betty which he has in his possession to him & his Heirs forever —

Fourthly I give & bequeath to my son James Hendrie my Negro boy Martin to him & his Heirs forever, he has now had his portion of Land and disposed of the same before —

Fifthly I give & bequeath to my son Ephraim Hendrie one hundred & fifty acres of Land whereon he now lives joining my son John & his Negro lands with my negro boys Aaron, Jack who he has in his possession to him & his Heirs forever —

Sixthly I give & bequeath to my son Green Hendrie one hundred & thirty five acres of Land which I purchased from James Snelton it being the two thirds of the land of John Green died which fell to his two daughters Lula & Anna together with my Negro boy Meredith & fifty dollars in money to him & his Heirs forever —

Eleven acres of Land conveyed to me by Upton Byrum & Thirtys acres of
Land conveyed to me by Aaron Wilson joining the above one hundred
Eleven acres also my Negro boy Adison, one year old he was the
Year preceding as his saddle & bridle one good feather & fur m. tree box
Sted & loaded together with fifty dollars in money to him this Heirs forever
Eighty. I give & bequeath to my daughter Lemy Smith her a Negro girl
which she has now in her possession, my Clarkson & Diana together with
The improvements & pasture in ironer it likewise whatever property she has
Received from me here before to her & her Heirs forever.

Worthy I loan to my daughter Margaret Bowditch the use of my two negro
girls, Mary during her natural life the use of my four negroes 1 viz
Dennis & Hassock & Dennis two Children Rachel & Sarah which she has
now in her possession & their income together with what other property
she has received from me & at her death to be equally divided among her
children to them & their heirs forever

I earnestly I desire to my Daughter Lucy Hanchett the use of my two Negro
girls, viz., Fanny & Leah during her natural life together with their in-
crease & one good feather bed & mattress bedstead & Cord & Twenty five
Dollars in money and at her death to be equally divided among the
Heirs of her own body to them & their Heirs forever. But in case she
Should die before she has parting issue of her own body, in that case
my will is that the property above named & described with its increase
if any shall be equally divided among her brothers & sisters & their Heirs
Elastically. What ever property I may have given to my six Sons
William, Peter, James, Ephraim & Ben & not mentioned in this will
consisting of Household furniture to be given & confided to them and
their Heirs forever.

Sweetly. My will is further that at the death of my beloved wife on
marriage all the Lands leased to her be divided between my two sons
George Hendrick & Thomas Hendrick in such a manner as to
include the dwelling house in Worcester Division running the
Division line so as to make their lands as near equal in value as
possible taking into view the law & settled to them both —

Thirteenth my will is that all & every part of my property not particularly mentioned above (after paying all my just debts) be equally

Second & last to gather among all the Carolina pioneers, to him this Heirs forever
Eightyly I give & bequeath to my daughter Lucy Smith her Negro Girls
which she has now in her possession viz, Maria & Diana together with
their present & future increase & likewise whatever property she has
Received from me here to fore to her & her Heirs forever.

Ninethly I leave to my daughter Margaret Morehead the use of my two Negro
girls Lucy & Fanny during her natural life the use of my four Negro Boys
Dennis & Hazen & Dennis two Children Rachel & Sarah which she has
now in her possession & their increase together with what other property
she has received from me at her death to be equally divided among her
children to them & their Heirs forever.

Tenthly I leave to my Daughter Lucy Hendrick the use of my two Negro
Girls, Lucy & Fanny during her natural life together with their in-
crease from good father land & furniture bedstead & couch & twenty five
Dollars in money and at her death to be equally divided among the
Heirs of her own body to them & their Heirs forever, But in case she
Should die before she has lawful issue of her own body, in that case
my will is that the property above named & described with its increase
if any shall be equally divided among her brothers & sisters or their heirs
Elevethly. What ever property I may have given to my four Sons
William, John, James, Ephraim & Ben & not mentioned in this will
consisting of Household furniture to be given equal to them and
their Heirs forever.

Twelvethly. My will is further that at the death of my beloved wife on
Marriage all the Lands leased to her be divided between my two Sons
Green Hendrick & Theodosius Hendrick in such a manner as to
include the dwelling house in Green's Division & running the
Division line so as to make their lands as near equal in Value as
possible taking into view the In. & will be to them both —
Thirteenth my will is that all & every part of my property not parti-
cularly mentioned above (after paying all my just debts) be equally
divided among my nine Children viz William, John, James,
Ephraim, Green, Dennis, Lucy, Margaret & Lucy or to their Heirs
also all the personal property leased to my wife at her death on
Marriage to be divided in like manner as above described —



to make the following distinction viz; that the personal property
that may fall to my daughter Margaret Meader agreeable to the
thirteenth Article I own to her during her natural life and at her
death to be equally divided with their increase among her children
to them & their heirs forever 15th And it further is my will that the
personal property that may fall to my daughter Lucy Hendrie
agreeable to the Thirteenth Article of this my will I own to her during
her natural life with the increase and at her death to be equally
divided among the heirs of her body to them & their heirs forever
but in case she shd die leaving no heirs of her own body, then
& in that case my will is that the above named property without its
increase be equally divided among her bro. & sis or their heirs
in testly I constitute & appoint my son in law Joseph Smith
to be executor of this my last will & testament declaring this to
be only to be my last will & witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 18th day of September A.D. 1828

of Mecklenburg State of North Carolina being in a sick & low condition
but of sound & disposing mind have thought proper to make this
my last will & testament as follows, after the payment of my just
Debts & funeral expenses — I bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Kirk
patrick a comfortable maintenance out of my estate during her
life or widowhood & to hold the farm & mansion house between
now & then but provided she shd marry I bequeath to her a
child & out of my estate & no more — I bequeath to my sons
John & James the plantation on Mickens creek adjoining
the plantation on which James Boyce now lives, if this plantation
should be to them more than any part there of the estate they should
pay in proportion to the other Estates if less they shall have an
