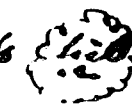

son in law & daughter Elizabeth. And unto this my last will & Testa-
ment I do constitute & appoint my two beloved sons Philip & To Oliver
Keepe as my lawful Executors. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this day & year just above written.

State of New Jersey, being weak in body but of sound mind & memory Thanks
be to God, therefore calling to mind that it appointed for all men once to die
do make & ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say Principally
& first of all I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of Almighty God
that gave it, And my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a
decent manner at the discretion of my Executors; And as touching
such worldly Estate whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me
in this life I give & dispose of the same in the following manner & form. I
give & bequeath to Mary Kees my beloved wife one mess called Fison
with one Bed & bed clothes together with the privilege of the use of
my dwelling house during her widowhood & one & eleven the one third
of all my moveable or Perishable property - Then I give & bequeath to
William Kees my beloved son the whole of the plantation on which I now
live

live together with one Spiering latter - Here. I give & bequeath
 unto Ann nee Eliza nee my beloved Neighbour all the remainder
 of my Personal property to be divided Equally between them -
 And I do hereby constitute & appoint Robert McKnight & Robert
Robinson both of Mecklenburg County & State of N. Carolina to be my sole
 Executors of this my last Will & Testament, And do hereby utterly disallow
 revoke & disannul all & every other former Wills & Testaments by me
 & Parents by me named Will or bequeathed before, Ratifying &
 confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament; In Witness
 whereof, the said John hereunto set my hand & seal
 this 28th day of May 1789 - A.D. The Wagon is to be for the use of the
 plantation & benefit of the family at large Also I give to my
 Beloved Son William here all my body clothes -

 & State of N. Carolina, being sick & in a low condition, but being
 of perfect mind & memory, do hereby testify that for the same
 I make my last Will & Testament after the following manner
 Impressed. I bequeath unto John Dickey for the use of
 Center Congregation the sum of Twenty pounds. Item the Remain-
 der of my Estate after my funeral expenses & all other debts is
 discharged, unto the eldest Son of David Ramsey named
 Ambrose, and Samuel Dickey's eldest Daughter Rachel to be
 equally divided between them to be possessed and enjoyed
 I declare & appoint my whole & sole Executors of this my last
 Will & Testament John Dickey & the next Young, And I
 do revoke all other Wills & Testaments made by me prior
 to this Will. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & seal in presence of us this 5th day of April
 A.D. 1792 -
