to my son James the feather bed & blanket, I give to
my niece to my daughter Elizabeth all that was her
sister's deceased. Likewise two feather beds & furniture
and all my cattle & all my household furniture and my
scoldle & spinning wheel; I also bequeath to my son James
one cow & harness such as he may choose. & what may
remain to be sold to the best advantage to pay my just debts
And I order & appoint David Shultz & Robert Karr to be
of this my last will & testament Given under my hand
I seal this 13th day of July in the year of our Lord 1811

" In the name of God our savior. I John Lemmon of the County of
Richlandings County State of Ohio Esquire living in a low state
of body, yet perfect in mind & memory, having considered the
mortality of man & that it is appointed for all men to die
and whereas it hath pleased God to take me health & send me
of the good things of this life. It is my will & desire that after
my decease they should be disposed in the manner & form as
follows viz - According to my giving & disposing my soul to God who
gave it to my body to the best to be decently interred at the
charge of my executors & my funeral charges to be paid
out of the value of my estate. I do give & bequeath to my
beloved wife Martha Lemmon my small mare named Jane
also the use privilege & benefit of my dwelling house which
will stand together with all the furniture belonging to the
same to her the same as her base during her widowhood
I therefore a good & sufficient man & in name part of the value
of my estate while she remains single, likewise one half
of the gang of hogs which are now between us viz my

and myself which she is to possess & enjoy at her own property forever
wherein all the property which she & I have the my wife was left
deposited at the time of our marriage before her death which she has
claimed as her own property — Item I do give & bequeath to my
eldest daughter Elizabeth Sennour to make the name of Mary
Saddles & Bridles one less. As further last & present — Item I do
give to my oldest son John a Horse & saddle named Sterling also an
saddle & bridle my rifle gun & accoutrements, one less, my big
boat, a part of my racing apparel, 1/10 a gang of hogs which he
claims as his own. Item I do give to my Q. son William Thomas
Senour and a bay horse named Dickie a saddle & bridle less a gang
of hogs which he is to claim. Item I do give to my youngest son Robert
my bay mare saddle & bridle, likewise the gang of hogs which he
now claims as his own likewise one less. Item I do give to my
youngest daughter Eleanor a horse least worth forty Dollars a saddle
& bridle also a feather bed & garniture one less & all the clothes
which were her mother's. Item It is my will & desire that my
negro fellow Aaron should be held back yearly to the highest bidder
for five years successively & the money arising therefrom to be
equally divided amongst my wife & children, after which
it is my will that a sufficient part of my estate should be sold at the old
method of my account as a full discharge of my just debts
& the balance of my property to be kept together for the support
of my family till my youngest child shall come to sound age
& then to be equally divided between my wife and children
Item It is my desire that all my land should be equally divided
between my three sons & that in dividing the land it might be
done in such manner so that I may comprehend the dwelling
house & all the out Buildings which I give & bequeath to my son

of hogs which he is to claim Item I do give to my youngest son Robert
my bay mare Saddal & Bridle, likewise the gang of hogs which he
now claims as his own likewise one cow. Item I do give to my
youngest daughter Eleanor a horse & saddle worth Sixty Dollars a saddle
& Bridle, also a feather bed & Garrison carbine & all the clothes
which were her mothers. Item It is my will & desire that my
Negro fellow Aaron should be hired out yearly to the highest bidder
for four years successively & the money arising therefrom to be
equally divided amongst my wife & children after which
sum the Negro to be sold to the highest bidder & the money to be
equally divided between my wife & children. Item It is my
will that a sufficient part of my estate should be sold at the sale
of my horses & shall discharge all my just debts
of my family till my youngest child shall come to full age
then to be equally divided between my wife and children
Item It is my desire that all my land should be equally divided
between my three sons & that in dividing the land it might be
convenient to have it in one tract so that I may comprehend the dwelling
house & all the out Buildings, which I give & give up to my youngest
son Robert Simonsen Item I do my wife presents & institute
the present and by this my last will & Testament do ap-
point my son & brother friends James & Peter & James the
executors to this my last will & Testament
