which I now live during her life in Widowhood

Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved son William Haffet
all this tract of Land on which I now live the property
to be transferred to him at the death or marriage. This
& Notwithstanding as the law may be; Item It is my further will
& pleasure that my Negre Wench Kate my other moveable
Estate be sold by my Executors and of the money thence
arising after all my Just debts are paid that I wish it
to be equally divided among my other children
My John Haffet, Jane Haffet, Rachel Haffet and
Robert Haffet. And I do hereby appoint my beloved
wife Margaret Haffet & my Brother Robert Haffet to be my
sole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament
hereby revoking all former Wills, Gifts & Legacies Made
-ing & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testa-
ment, Sealed with my Seal & dated this 14th day of
June in the year of our Lord 1775.

hereby revoking all former wills, gifts & legacies made
- by & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testa-
