I will the whole of my property to James Spratt leaving my Bequests  
to him & his Heirs forever — I also hereby nominate James Spratt  
Executor of this my last will & Testament and I do hereby re-  
mire James Spratt Guardian of this my Testable in her life  
whereof I do here set my hand & seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1825

In the name of God amen. — On the 20<sup>th</sup> day of February 1822 I do publish my will hereby making & publishing my will & memory thereof being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory that unto my good friends & neighbors calling unto mind the uncertainty of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make & ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say Principally & first of all I give & command my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I give & command to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God; and as touching such worldly estate wherewith I have pleased God to bless in this life I give & command as follows in the following manner & form first I give & command to let my body be laid by the side of this plantation and lie on as long as the laws & custom of the land & neighborhood will allow the other half of the said plantation and at the same time the same is to be given to the said John Hartman
