 in Blood of Christ - And as touching the good things of this

Which God in his Good Providence has bestowed upon me, I dispose of as follows viz. The whole to remain together the 1st & my well beloved wife surviving me as far as she may choose for her own comfort & maintenance. That I Will & bequeath that upon my decease & that of my wife my whole Estate real & personal to John M. Wilson a Minister of the Gospel my good friend to him his Heirs & assigns forever. In consideration of which I confide in the said John M. Wilson to exercise at all times necessary a strict & able care & circumspection about me & my wife during our natural lives & at our death. That I do hereby constitute & appoint my Executor from & hereby provide John M. Wilson Minister of the Gospel the sole Executor of my last Will and Testament. — Published this 20th day of February AD 1822. The 20th day of February 1822 Published in Landrick of Johnson County fresh & feeling very sick & that in being but of perfect mind & memory that he begins to feel the necessity of casting unto me the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die; Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament, that is to say Principally & first of all, I give & recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God; and as I am being much sorely afflicted with it has pleased God to bless in this life I give & bequeath of the same in the following manner & give first I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife the half of this plantation I do live on as long as she lives, & after to my well beloved daughter Lettie McCondrick the other half of the said plantation and at her decease she is to leave it to the said Lettie McCondrick & if she
