ever to die do make & declare this my last will & testament in the
manner & form following. First of all I recommend my soul to
God who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a Christian
manner & decent manner at the discretion of my executors here
in after my death, and as touching such worldly estate as I shall
please God to bless me in this life, I give & dispose of the same as
follows, first I will that my just debts, & funeral expences be paid
I do beseeche as soon as convenient after my decease, the principle
I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Susannah all
the Houschold Utencils furniture that she has brought me &
that is as good or better & replace as when first brought & however
all the money that is coming to her by the last will of her late
husband, which sum cannot at present be ascertained the
estate not being as yet settled, & three hours & three quarters
of my stock & one hundred & thirty dollars in fees of her years per
annum for her & her family, all to be for uses & behoofe & to be wholly
her disposal ~~These~~ I leave unto my son Matthew the plantation
he now lives on containing 200 acres & that part of the land
land I now live on which lies to the south west of the creek running
through the same containing 30 acres be the same mine or less
This Head forever in fee simple. It however lies unto my son Matthew
my Negro man named Hercules he paying unto his step Mr. John
Susannah the sum of one hundred dollars at the end of three years
upon my decease & that if she is then living & remains my widow
& it shall not be lawful for my son Matthew to sell or convey the
land here left him until the said 100 dollars is paid or secured
to be paid to my widow at the time it may become due; and it
is my will that the plantation above lies on containing 100
acres (Accepting that part of the land left to my son Matthew) 450
acres beginning the same & land of Joseph W. Hammons in Capo. & to
sell as soon as convenient after my decease & the money arising
from sale & the sale of all my personal property (Accepting my

through the same containing 80 acres be the same more or less
this sum forever in fee simple. If however he leave unto my son Matthew
1000 acres more than Hercules he paying unto his step Mr. this
sum and the sum of one hundred dollars at the end of three years
after my decease & that if she is then alive & remains my widow
& it shall not be lawful for my son Matthew to sell or convey the
land here left him until the said 1000 dollars is paid or secured
to be paid to my widow at the time it may become due; and it
is my will that the plantation now lies on containing 100
acres (Excepting that part of the ~~land~~ left to my son Matthew) 450
acres adjoining the same & land of Joseph Hannon be exposed to
sale as soon as convenient after my decease & the money arising
therefrom to be paid off the debts & expenses of my
widow & myself & the sum of one thousand one hundred and one
dollar and one pence and no farthings more or less

My wife to Hugh Foster & his said wife to John Williams, whose
wife to Samuel Gordon & his wife to Johnathan Gordon their
sonne also deceased & to his son Johnathan Gordon their
sonne to make as good a title as a title of conveyance to the person having
of my land & timber hold as myself could have done in my lifetime &
when necessarily present & I do by this my last will & testament
appoint my son Matthew & my son in law Samuel Gordon &
Johnathan Gordon to be the sole executors of this my last will &
testament hereby revoking all former testaments or parts hereof so
made. Ratifying & confirming this to be my last will & testament.

six head of sheep fifteen head of hogs, eight of them two years old &
seven, year old, likewise a negro woman named Lucy, likewise
a negro boy named Charles, the said plantation & plantation of
Charles, my wife, use her lifetime, & then rest of the mentioned property
to go to my son Robert Hawie after the death of my
