

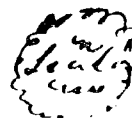
John & I do hereby to be my whole & sole Executors of this my last

Carolina & County of Hatteras, being very sick & weak in body
& my mind & memory thanks be given to Almighty God
calling to mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die. Do make & Decline this my last Will & Testament -
I give & recommend my Soul unto Almighty God that gave it, & my
Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian
burial at the discretion of Executors hereafter mentioned and as
Touching such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with in
this life, I give & devise & dispose of the same in the following manner
I give, I give I do will & allow all my lawfull debts to be discharged
out of my personal Estate, Then I do will & bequeath to my dearly
beloved wife Mary Harrison one third of my personal Estate toge-
ther with my bay mare & her own saddle also her living off the plan-
tation & the use of the house during her widowhood, likewise three
Cows & and four Sheep for the use & support of my family also
New plow & plow hoes & three set of horse gears. Also my large horse
Young Round horse & Dick for the use & support of my family.
(Then I also give & bequeath to my son in law William Drishill that
plantation which he now lives on & a Dec of conveyance to be
made him by my executors. Then I will & bequeath all the Lands
(I am possessed of to my three Sons James, John & Elias to be equally
divided according to the nature of it to be left to the discretion
of my Executors) James to have the house I now live in, also my
Barn & other Office houses - if my wife be pregnant with a male
Child, then three Sons, James, John & Elias is to pay him each of

them thirty pounds if a female to have an equal share with the rest
of my daughters. To my son Robert I will fifty pounds of my personal
estate also an equal share of my personal estate with the rest of my
children. I do also will & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth
thirty pounds of my personal estate besides her equal share with the
rest of my daughters. Item If any one or more of my sons die before
they come to the years of maturity then his or their part of the estate
to bevest to the surviving party & if one or more of my daughters
should die before they come to the years of maturity, then her or their
part to bevest to the surviving parties. Item I do positively
order my son James when the care of my daughter Elizabeth shall
come to her natural life if she does not marry. Item I do will &
bequeath the twenty pounds of my personal estate for schooling my children
Item All my personal estate not mentioned to the above legacies I do
order to be sold at public vendue. Item I do likewise make constitute
& declare my beloved wife Mary Harrison, Robert Harrison, Item
Dishill & Samuel a trustee of my whole & sole executor of this my
last will & testament. I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul
all & every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Bequests & contents by
me in any way before made written & bequeathed. Notifying and
confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 30th day of August
in the year of our Lord 1777.

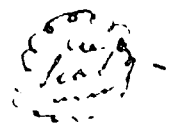

August the 30th 1777. A Schedule
I John Harrison do positively order & will to my son James out
of my personal estate my Yearling Stallion colt in consideration of his
maintaining his sister Elizabeth. Item I do also will to my daughter
Sarah the sum of twelve & the bay mare colt. Item I do likewise
will to my daughter Jane out of my personal estate a new rich
saddle. & lastly I do will & bequeath all the crop of wheat
that & lain here on my plantation for the use & support of my
children. I do my hand & seal the day & year above written

thirty pounds of my personal Estate besides her equal share with the rest of my daughters. Item If any one or more of my sons die before they come to the years of Maturity then his or their part of the Estate to devolve to the Surviving party & if one or more of my daughters should die before they come to the years of Maturity, then his or their part to devolve back to the Surviving parties. Item I do positively order my Son James when the care of my daughter Elizabeth during her natural life if she does not marry. Item I do will & assign the Twenty pounds of my personal Estate for schooling my Children. Item All my personal Estate not mentioned to the above Legacies I do order to be sold at public Vendue. Item I do likewise make constitute & declare my beloved wife Mary Morrison, Robert Morrison, John Driskill & Samuel Montgomery my whole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament, & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, Bequests & Executors by me in any wise before named With which & against them. Notifying and confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 30th Day of August in the Year of our Lord 1777.

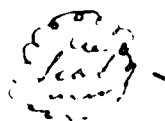
