 but of a sound disposing mind blessed be God calling to
 mind the Mortality of the body & that it is appointed unto
 men once to die, do make this my last Will & Testament
 in the manner & form following Viz first & principally
 I recommend my soul to God & my body to the earth to
 be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my
 Executors Herein after mentioned And Touching such
 worldly substance as it hath pleased God to bless me with
 I give & dispose of as follows first I Will that my just
 debts be paid as soon as convenient after my death.

I Will unto my well beloved wife Mary Ann full possession
 of all my property during her life, I Will unto William
Bibb my negro woman whole, beside Agnes & at the
 death of wife my woman Hall, And at his death William
Bibb his death to his Heirs the above named Agnes -
 I Will & bequeath to William Bibb the son William
 has none in possession the offspring of my woman Agnes
 & at the death of my wife my negro boy John & at the
 death of him viz William Bibb to his Heirs forever.
 I Will unto Philip & Bibb my negro man Henry &
Leroy & my girl Eldy to have his lifetime and at his
 death to his Heirs forever -

I will unto Elizabeth Sherpely my negro man John & his wife & their five children viz John & Samuel & Charles & Sally & Rachel & their increase & all her debts to her body by His power - I will unto Nancy Ingram my negro girl Eliza & my boy Philip & my girl Bel & at her death to her body by His - I will that my negro Peter be sold & that fifty dollars of the money he may sell for be paid to my grand daughter Levenworth Ingram & the balance of the price of him Peter be equally divided between my five grand children first above named. I will & bequeath the plantation whereon I now live to Philip A. Bibb & at his death to his Heirs. It is my will that each of my legates first above named pay their mother Polly Powell five dollars per year - during her life - And lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint my friends Solomon Reed & John Fulwood to be the executors of this my last will & testament, hereby revoking & making void all other wills made by me Actifying & confirming this to be my last will and testament be witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal October 10th 1827 -
