but of a sound disposing mind blessed by God calling to his
spirit the Mortality of the body. That it is appointed unto
men once to die, do make this my last will & testament
in the manner & form following viz first I principally
recommend my soul to God & my body to this earth to
be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my
executors herein after mentioned and touching such
probable substance as it hath pleased God to bless me with
I give & dispose of as follows first I will that my just
debts be paid as soon as convenient after my death.

I will unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth full & plen
of all my property during her life. I will unto William Bibb
wife my negro woman slave, beside his wife & after
death of wife my son Hall, who at his dying will shall
divide death to his heirs the above named negroes -

I will & bequeath to William Bibb the four children he
has now in proportion the offspring of my woman slave
& at the death of my wife my negro boy John & at the
death of him viz William Bibb to his heirs forever.

I will unto Philip A. Bibb my negro man Henry &
Lucy & my girl Eddy to have his lifetime and at his
death to his heirs forever -

I will unto Elizabeth Sherley my negro woman & her
 Silver his wife & their four children viz John & Mary
 Chesley, Silver & Rachel & their increase & children to be
 her Bodyly Heirs forever - I will unto Nancy Ingram
 my negro girl Eliza & my boy Philip & my girl Bet &
 at her death to her Bodyly Heirs - I will that my negro
 Peter be sold & that fifty dollars of the money he may
 sell for be paid to my grand daughter Sophannah Ingram
 & the balance of the price of him Peter be equally divided
 between my four grand children first above named.
 I will & bequeath the plantation wherson I now live
 to Philip Abbott & at his death to his Heirs, It is my
 will that each of my legatees first above named pay
 them mother Polly Powell five dollars per year -
 during her life - wherefore I do hereby nominate
 & appoint my friend Solomon Reed & Job Fulwood
 to be the executors of this my last will & testament, hereby
 revoking & making void all other wills made by me
 Actifying & confirming this to be my last will and
 testament In testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & affixed my seal October 10th 1827 -
