Dollars & two head of horned cattle & two head of sheep -
Eighth It is my Will that my Wagon, Haws & two horses be kept for the
use of the plantation, I also allow the negroes Sampson & Dick be
kept on the plantation for the use thereof until my son William
arrives of age & the residue of my property not herein specially
bequeathed I allow to be sold at public Auction, & the money
arising from the same to be equally divided among my wife
& children - And Lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my
friend William Potts of Virginia & his heirs to the Executors of
this my last Will & Testament; And I do hereby revoke all
other Will or Wills by me heretofore made, Respecting this &
no other to be my last Will & Testament In Testimony
whereof I the said James Potts hereunto set my hand
& seal this 10th day of July A.D. 1821.
