 the one half of all my estate to her own use & behoof -
Then I also will & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter
Mary the other half of my estate to be put to interest till she
 becomes of Age - And for the true Execution of this my last
 will & Testament I do choose & appoint my well beloved
 brother Burton Pinnix to be whole & sole Executor of this
 my last will as witness my hand & seal this 19th of July 1793

In the name of God Amen. I Robert Phillips
 of Northampton County State of North Carolina, being in health of
 body & sound mind & memory (blessed be God) but calling to mind
 the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men
 once to die, do make this 23rd day of August in the year of our Lord
 1793 make & confirm this my last will & Testament in manner to
 be in following W^{ts}. Item I give & bequeath my soul into
 the hands of Almighty God to be saved, desiring for a gracious
 acceptance thro' the merits of Jesus Christ my only Saviour; & my
 body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a Christian like &
 decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereafter to be
 named, into my lawful goods whereunto it has pleased God to be
 & bless me with I dispose of in the following manner -
Item I desire is that after my decease all my just debts
 be paid out of my estate by my hereafter named Executors -
Item I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Jane Phillips (by way of
 an annuity) a house & lot, a further tract & plantation & fifty
 part of profits arising from the cultivation of the plantation where
 she now lives & a house to live in during the term she shall live
