& after her death the said land is to be sold to the best advantage
& the money so arising from such sale to be equally divided
between the three lands John, Peter, Mary & Elizabet
Pfeifer & it is herwines my will that such land as are willed to
my said Ch. & C. as above is to be Lived & treated from year to
year & the rest of each child's land is to be applied to the end of
Cloathing & Shewing & Schooling them untill they shall come of age.

any of my children should die before he has or them shall be of
full age that then & in that case the Estate & the slaves shall be
equally divided between the survivors or survivors of my children
and further it is my will that so long as my said wife does continue
to live single & in the capacity of a widow she may continue
to live on the premises which I have hitherto lived on there
all the profits of mills & plantations only to make no distinction
use of timber except so much as will be wanting for repairing
& keeping the houses & plantations in good order & for house use to
the end that she shall rear my children but in case she should
after her lifetime of life & marry it is then my Will & meaning that
my said children shall be under the care & direction of my
executors hereinafter mentioned & that as soon as they shall attain
to my said wife to leave the said premises unto them the executors
of my will upon which they are forthwith directed to vest &
Leave the said premises as above mentioned, & further as touching
my Personal estate it is my will that as soon as my debts &
paid my funeral expenses discharged by my executors and remaining
the sum of ten pounds as an acknowledgment to them together with
a reasonable allowance, in their trouble; that whatever there is
remaining if any, it is my will that the one third part of my said
personal estate be given to my said wife, the remaining two thirds
to be divided equally between my children, It is also my will
I do hereby request my executors to take all due & suitable pains
to have my herein mentioned children instructed in the Christian
Faith & to have a reasonable Education & particularly my said

should be any deficiency of my personal estate left to his share, also

the end that she shall rear my children but in case she should
after her return of life & marry it is then my Will & meaning that
my said children shall be under the care & direction of my
executors herein after mentioned & that as soon as they shall direct
her my said wife to quit the said premises unto them the executors
of my will upon which they are forth with directed to pay to
Leave the said premises as above mentioned, & further as touching

executors & the money arising from such sale to be applied to the

such time in the name of my son Pease & wife if to be sold
the proprietor & if not to be applied to the use of my said son

son John for the use of my son John, & I gave & bequeath to my
beloved James Deacon my late released brother his paying
nothing the remainder of my apparel I.g. as & I give with a
my son John together with my hats & Stock Cloths & the remain-
der of my estate I desire to be sold &c. &c; paying my just
debt & funeral charges I allow the remainder to be divided
into three equal parts to be left my wife & two children
in Williams part to be paid to Interst. until they come
of age. I now sign & constitute make & ordain my
beloved wife Sarah Patterson & Joseph Reed & Joseph
Patterson my executors of this my last will & testament
& I do hereby disallow, revoke & disannull all other former
Testaments, Wills, legacies, bequests & executors by me in any
wise made or done, Ratifying & confirming this & none but
