 & furniture & every thing in my bed room including Chest
 & drawers - I do bequeath to my brother Lease Price
 my negro boy William & my three horses named Peacock
 Mary & Gipsy - I do bequeath to Isabella Campbell
 my negro Girl Malinda - I do bequeath to Henry Cure
 my waggon & hind gear - I do bequeath to my brother William
Price & Isaac Price, also Henry Cure all the rest of my real
 & personal after my lawful debts are paid & it
 to be equally divided between the three last mentioned.
 I do bequeath & appoint my two brothers William Price
Lease Price & George Henry my executors of this my last will
 & Testament to the effect that I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal this 3^o of February in the Year of our Lord 1816
