 sets resighted to all who have any right to give it to my body  
 to be interred with me in the manner & place I before wrote  
 all my just debts to be paid etc. I do bequeath to my  
 beloved mother Mrs. Price my Negro Girl Dina & her to be  
 aged thirty & all the farming tools with all the black cattle  
 & hogs on my house called Chick to go to her in my inc.  
 farm land & 1000 dollars in my bed room including chest  
 tables etc. I do bequeath to my brother Isaac Price  
 my negro boy Mattie & his three horses named Peacock  
 Lucy & Bridger etc. I do bequeath to Gabriel Campbell  
 my negro girl Malinda & I do bequeath to Henry Cox  
 my wagon & hind gears. I do bequeath to my brother William  
Price & Isaac Price below Henry Cox all the rest of my real  
 & personal effects my意图 with exception only of it  
 to be equally divided between the three last mentioned.  
 I do bequeath & appoint my two Brothers William Price  
Isaac Price & George Henry my executors of this my last will  
 & testament to witness whereof these presents setting hand  
 unto date this 3<sup>d</sup> of February in the year of our Lord 1812.
