

WILL OF JOHN PURSER

593, P 102 JOHN PURSER 28 Mar 1824, prb in May 1826
Ct. Being well assured of the certainty of death and
the uncertainty of the time I am to resign my body to
death, I will to my wf (unnamed), during her lifetime,
all the premises belonging to the 73-acre tract I purchased
from John Cuthbertson being all the land I own on the south
side of Goose Cr. and at her demise sd land is to descend
to my son Richard Purser. If the land in litigation be-
tween Arthur Smith and the heirs of George Smartt is set-
tled in favor of the sd Smith, the sd land at the decease
of my wf I will (her interest in sd land?) to my son David
Purser. I also will to my son Richard my interest in sd
land in litigation. All of my movable property is to be
sold and from the proceeds, together with money on hand
and the collection of debts owed to me, after my just debts
are paid, I give to my sons Moses and Robert and to my daus
Sarah, Elizabeth, Lucy and Dorcas each £5, and the remain-
der is to be equally divided among my wf and sons David and
Richard.
