equally divided amongst my wife & children this to be done by
two or more men of judgment & discretion to do it -

Lastly I do hereby appoint my son James ^{as his} Executor of
this my last Will & Testament & I choose him in case of sickness
or long emergency to call to his assistance my son John with
H Craig. And do by these presents revoke & disannul all other
wills & testaments & direct this to be my last Will & Testament.

into the hands of almighty God that gave it to my body recommended
to the earth to be buried in decent Christian manner at the
discretion of my executors nothing doubting ... that at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
power of God, and as touching such worldly goods which

it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise & dispose
 of the same in this following manner & form first I give and
 bequeath to the poor of the County three pounds Proclamation
 Money. I also give to my brother Jacob Ramsom & David
Ramsom all my lands with all the appurtenances there unto
 belonging to be equally divided between them Him. I give &
 bequeath my Cash & all my ~~useable~~ estate to Jacob Ramsom
 & David Ramsom to be equally divided betwixt them first
 paying each of my heirs fifty pounds proclamation money.
 And I do constitute make & ordain Jacob Ramsom and
David Ramsom sole Executrix of this my last will and
 Testament. And I do hereby utterly disannul revoke and
 disallow all & every other former Testaments Wills Legacies
 bequests & Executrixes Ratifying & confirming this said other
 to be my last will & Testament. In witness hereof I have here
 unto set my hand & seal this 16th day of February in the year of
 our Lord 1766 - Signed Sealed Published pronounced & declared by
 the said John Ramsom as his last will & Testament in the
