County & Barbadoes, being of sound & perfect mind & memory &  
commonly blessed be God, I do this 10<sup>th</sup> day of February in  
the year of our Lord 1818 do make & publish this my last will  
& Testament in the manner following, that is to say I, am ob-  
liged unto my beloved wife Catharine Reed the whole  
benefit of the plantation I now live on, with all, growing & to be  
Held in its like household furniture & fixings without exception  
are saved more two Cows & Calves chosen, what sheep & hogs  
on hand at my decease to have & to hold for her own proper  
use her life time and at her decease all to be sold & equally  
divided amongst all my children my son J. P. i. t. t.  
to receive his share when & after opportunity taken place  
& at my decease the rest of my land & other property not men-  
tioned in my will to be sold to the best advantage &  
equally divided amongst all the before mentioned  
children whereupon I set my hand & seal the 1st January

in a decent & Christian like manner at the discretion  
of my Executors. Second With regard to such worldly  
estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with, I direct that  
all my just debts & funeral expenses be first paid as  
soon as convenient after my decease. Third I give devise  
& bequeath unto my only & beloved wife Polly my bed &  
its furniture, two whirts one large & one small & one  
pair of Cards, two chest & side chairs, my cupboard  
Vit, furniture, all my Kitchen furniture including  
the dresser & its furniture, also my Mere iron ha-  
sed like & brick, two plates one gopher & one Earthen  
vam. set of plates & cutlerys, also two Cows & Calves  
her choice out of my flock & all my Sheep Hogs & Pigs to  
be there more or less, with all the before mentioned  
property I do hereby confirm unto her Polly my wife  
as appears and to be for her use & to be disposed at her dis-  
cretion during her natural life, and what of it remains  
at her death to be left I direct to be equally among
