

In the name of God Amen. Being in a poor weak state of
body but of a sound mind & judgment, calling to mind the mor-
tality of my body do judge it my duty to make & constitute this
my last will & testament. And first I do give & bequeath unto my son
to God that gave it to my body to be entered at the discretion
of my friends being certain that it shall be used at the last day
and of the good things of this life which God hath given me
I also dispense of in the following manner. First I do give &
bequeath to my loving wife Martha Rogers the third part of
the plantation during her undiminished life. Third of all.

My ready property or personal estate to be as follows.
John Eldest son Hugh Rogers having given him already
of his part I only therefore allow him ten shillings Sterling
giving my son John Rogers I have given him already off his
share. Therefore I allow my son John Rogers ten shillings Sterling. giving
my son John Rogers I do give & bequeath the
plantation to see him out till going to the land, and the
remainder of the personal property only what is here after
named to others. Giving to my oldest daughter Elizabeth White
Hatch I have given already what I allowed her therefore
I give her ten shillings Sterling giving to my son in law
William Bennett having given him what I allowed him
with my daughter Margaret I do allow him five shil-
lings Sterling giving to my daughter Martha Rogers I do
allow her Thirty pounds to be given in property at the
value of two men giving to my daughter Sally Rogers I
do allow Thirty pounds to be given in property at the
value of two men - giving to my daughter Hannah Rogers
I do allow her Thirty pounds to be paid in property at the
value of two men - I do further give my two daughters Sally
Rogers & William Hatch to be my executors to see this my last
will & testament performed according to the true intent &
meaning thereof I do hereby empower William Scott as
my attorney to sue & collect before this my last will &
testament presented, for unto unto my legal death this 15th

of September 1785. - Signed sealed published & affixed
