

In the name of God Amen. Being in a very weak state of
body but of a sound mind & judgment, calling to mind the mor-
tality of my body do judge it my duty to make & constitute this
my last will & testament. And first I do give & bequeath my soul
to God that gave it & my body to be entialed at the discretion
of my friends being certain that it shall be used at the last day
unto of the good things of this life which God hath given me
I also dispose of in the following manner. First I do give &
bequeath to my loving wife Mather Rogers the third part of
the plantation during her widowhood, & third of all
moveable property in personal estate to be at her disposal.
2^{dy} my eldest son Henry Rogers I having given him already
of his part I only therefore allow him ten shillings sterling
3^{dy} my son John Rogers I have given him already off his
share therefore I allow him ten shillings sterling 4th
my son John Kincaid Rogers I do give & bequeath the
plantation & move him out of all ~~my~~ other lands and the
remainder of the personal property only what is here after
bequeathed to others - 5th to my eldest daughter Elizabeth the
Walsh I have given already what I allowed her therefore
I give her ten shillings sterling 6th To my son in law
William Burnett having given him what I allowed him
with my daughter I therefore I do allow him five shil-
lings sterling 7th to my daughter Mather Rogers I do
allow her thirty pounds to be given in property at the
value of two men 8th To my daughter Sally Rogers I
do allow thirty pounds to be given in property at the
value of two men - 9th To my daughter Frances Rogers
I do allow her thirty pounds to be paid in property at the
value of two men - I do authorize my two nephews John
Rogers & William Walsh to be my Executors to see this my last
will & testament presented according to the true intent &
meaning thereof I do hereby empower William Scott as
juror & an Obedient Executor to see this my last will &
testament presented. ~~Forwitness~~ my hand & seal this 15th
of September 1785. Signed sealed & delivered in the presence
of John White
