 mortal life beseech be God for the same, do make this my
 last will & testament in manner & form following
that is to say I give my soul to Almighty God who gave it
 & my body I commit to the Mother Earth to be buried in
 a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my
 executors Item I give unto my beloved wife Katherine Sim-
mons all my negro property that I now possess to wit Rose
Hannay, Doctor & Jumbo with all my household & kitchen
 furniture of whatever name they may be of with all my
 cows & horses now on the farm forever & at her death to be
 at her disposal to whom she may think best deserving
 of all her children, Likewise the whole of the plantation
 during her natural life that I now have on. Likewise all
 my hogs for her use -- Item I give & bequeath to Mr. J. W.
William the sum of one dollar Item I give to my Daughter Sally
 Kimbrell the sum of one dollar Item I give to my Daughter
 Betty Simmons the sum of one dollar Item I give to my
 Grandson John Simmons son to my son John one hundred
& twelve to be given the said John by my son James Sim-
mons when the said John at the age of twenty one --
 Item I give & devise to my son James Simmons the whole of
 my plantation on Stony Creek that I now have on after the
 death of my wife Katherine -- Item I give & bequeath to
 Daughter Katherine Thirteen one dollar Item I give & bequeath
 to my daughter Molly DeArmond the sum of one dollar
 be it remembered that my son James is to have all the above
 property as he is to be heir to land after my wife Katherine dies
 Likewise the said James Simmons is to pay all my just
 & lawful debts now due him I likewise do nominate
 & appoint my well beloved & trusty friends Joseph & William
McKenzie my sole executors of this my last will
& testament hereby revoking all former wills & testaments made
 by me whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the 16th day of January in the year of our Lord 1811.

lives upon purchased by me from Morris Moore & like was fifty
acres lying on the west side of Dobb's line, I also bequeath
to my daughter Jane a negro girl named Katie—
I also will & bequeath to my son George all my real and
personal estate he paying my funeral Ditty— I also
constitute & appoint my sons James Stafford & George
Stafford my Executrix to this my last will & testament
