I John Sloan of Charlotteburg County & State of N^o Carolina, being
sick & weak of body but of perfect sound mind & memory but call
to mind my mortality & that it is appointed for man to die, Do this
28th day of March 1806 make this my last will & Testament
in manner & form following Viz. And first I will that all my
Just Debts be honestly paid by my Executors herein after named
And I bequeath to my beloved wife Margaret all the household
Drops & Kitchen furniture & my Negro Girl Hannah & what
money I have in hand & what is owing to me to be at her own
disposal. Also my black mare & all my neat cattle hogs & sheep
with her saddle & truck, And to her full possession of this my
Mansion house & to have a gentle living off my farm & to have
the whole profits arising from the same during her widowhood
with the farming utensils & what grain & meat is on hand at
present. - And to my nephew, Robert Sloan son John Sloan
I bequeath Fifty Acres of Land, joining the land his father
lives on to begin at my lower corner on the bank of the river
& to run up the river as far as will make the said fifty Acres
I give & crop the lower end of my land to him & his heirs
And to William Bigham son of William Bigham of Lincoln
County that now lives & has lived with me for some time
past I bequeath all the remainder of the tract of Land where
I now live be it more or less not to hurt or molest my
widow during her widowhood, Also my gray mare
known by the name of his own & saddle that is his own
& saddle to him & his heirs forever And to Mr. Bease
Miller Bealy & Thomas Woods Bealy sons of Joseph Bealy of
Tennessee State I bequeath my young gray mare
which I do hereby name & appoint Robert Sloan my

Mechlenburg County & William Higham of Lincoln County
 Executors of this my last Will & Testament, hereby renouncing
 all former wills & wills, Testament & Testaments by me formerly
 made - Signed Sealed pronounced & declared by
 the said John Hearn the Testator to be his last
 Will in the presence of us the subscribing witnesses
 who also signed in the presence of each other -

I Robert Sibley of State of N^o Carolina Mechlenburg County
 being weak in body but perfect mind & memory, but calling to
 mind the mortality of my body knowing it is appointed once
 for men to die, I first commit my body to the dust from
 whence it came - And my soul to God who gave - -
 And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it is the
 pleased to bless me with in this life I will & bequeath in
 manner & form following - 1st I will that all my Estates
 both real & personal be sold at the highest bidder at
 Twelve months credit & the money equally divided be
 tween my wife & six Children by name John Sibley, Robert
 & Paddy Sibley, Gabriel & Leonard & Elijah - 2^d I will
 that Twenty dollars be taken of my son John Sibleys
 Legacy & equally divided my wife & other five children
 above named - 3^d I nominate & appoint my son
 Elijah Sibley & Thomas Dexter my Executors to manage
 my affairs agreeable to my Will. I also disannul revoke
 & disallow all other Legacies, Dowry, Wills, right or titles
 of Dowry but this & this only to be my last Will & Testament
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal
 this 4th day of September 1809
