William Harkett July 23

In the name of God Amen. I John Stevens of the County of Rockingham State of North Carolina, far advanced in life, but informs but perfectly sound in mind & memory thank be God for it, doth make this 23rd day of August in the year of our Lord 1800. That I publish and declare this to be my last will & Testament in the name of God, "knowing that it to say,

1st I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Harkett Stevens a piece of land supposed to contain Twenty acres to run as follows to the same more or less beginning on the line between W.L. Davidson and the Head of Robert Harkett's Northeast corner said to be a pine in my Deed out of the corner of the dividing line between the said the Head of the said Harkett Stevens running S.E. through eight degrees West until it strikes the South, then run left the mainline of said branch to the mouth of the first small branch running in on the North side of the before mentioned branch, then up the mainline of said branch bearing to the West with W.L. Davidson line next to the South West side or Black Oak, there with my old line supposed to be North fifty seven East to the beginning to be here and his Head, from thence I also give & bequeath to her the said Elizabeth Stevens one small pot, one middle sized bowl, one Pewter candle stick, and all the cupboard & drupper furniture, also my fiddy or Young m.c.

2d I give & bequeath to my son William all the Balance of the lands & live stock belonging except the before mentioned piece agreeable to the Books and bounds before mentioned, for my daughter Elizabeth to be her and her first son and daughter. It is my will and desire that the whole Balance of lands & goods of my property not expressly mention before to sale in a publick manner at such time monthly or by my Executors, part of the proceeds of which I allow all my just debts to be paid, then should there remain a Balance

After paying my debts, it is my will that the sum of £1000/-
divide between my four Daughters & their late legitimate
constitute and represent my trusty friend John Hulme
my Executor to execute this my last will & Testament so far as
whereof I John Stark the Testator have so this my last will &
Testament set my hand & seal the day & year first above written

In the name of God amen Know ye before whom these presents my
son that William Stark being weak in body & failing in mind
and memory, do make & appoint this my last will & Testament
And first I do assign my body to the ground from whence it
was taken, and my soul to him who gave it Relying on his
mercy with full assurance... My corporal concerns I make
after the following manner

I require all my Debt to be paid before any distribution of
property takes place.

I leave my bed & furniture & my negro boy Jeff to be sold
at 6 Twelvemonths credit and the sum to be equally divided
between my beloved brother Charlton Stark & sister Nancy Stark
all the monies arising from my other estate to me and also
from my Brother Josiah is to be given. I give & bequeath also
equally to my brother Charlton Stark & sister Nancy Stark
all monies arising to me my brother David Stark Estate to
me I give and bequeath also to my Brother Charlton and
sister Nancy Stark equally

I also constitute, nominate & appoint James Doherty
Executor of this my last will and Testament - hereby
reserving making void all other wills or testaments by me ever
before made in writing or otherwise. The testaments
whereof I have herunto set my hand & affixed my seal
this 20th day of December 1826
