care of my Friends to be buried in a decent
and christian like manner at the discretion
of my executors.

I will that my just debts and funeral
charges be paid. That my three youngest
children have schooling sufficient for them
proportionally that my three oldest daughters viz
Sarah Margaret & Ann have each the
Bed headboards & furniture which they
have heretofore called their own. That a
full years provision be laid in for
the whole family that the Elder
children may be enabled to raise
the youngest ones & that they have
the use of the ~~land~~ half of the cleared
land. The Wagon the Thrasher one
Horse ten Sheep ~~and~~ cows & calves & all
Remaining household & Kitchen
Furniture. Farming utensils as far
as this last shall be needed to remain
unsold until the youngest child comes
of age for the common use of all while
they remain in a single state after the
youngest child comes of age the Land
must be valued & what of this property
may then remain shall be sold and
equally divided.

I will that the remaining part of
the parishable property now here in
already disposed of be put to sale

that the monies on hand together with
 what ~~money~~ arrive from the sale be put
 to keep ~~as~~ interest for the equal benefit
 of all my children I share to share a like
 payable to them on their legal representation
 when they come ~~of age~~ those of them that are
 already of age can have theirs on demand.

I will that the Land be not sold But
 that my son George have the right of
 working or ~~utilizing~~ that half of the
 cleared land not before mentioned un-
 till the youngest child shall be of age
 then the ~~whole~~ tract to be valued and
 my two sons George & William to have
 it equally between them on condition
 that they pay to the rest of the heirs their
 proportion of the estimated value.

I will that my son George in addition
 to and equal ~~privilege~~ in the Land
 shall have ~~the~~ equal privilege in the
 use of the Waggon & Throader while
 these articles remain common property.
 Secondly I will that all my children from
 the Eldest to the youngest be furnished
 with a bible and a hymn Book when
 they can gull their own.

and I do here by nominate and
 appoint my son George Howey and
 Matthew Gordon to be the executors
 of this my last ~~will and~~ testament hereby
 Rescinding all former Wills by me here
 to fore made in testimony whereof
 I do hereunto set my hands

Item, that I give unto Beulah unto
Martha of all away my wife one third
part of my plantation whereon I live
while she remains my widow being
beginning at William's Hut on the

the field to a pine tree at the fence then
the same course to the first hollow
then running with the meadows of the
Hollow to a stake on a red line
near the big Spring.
