In the name of God Amen, I John Swann of Mecklenburg  
County, State of N Carolina, Being weak in body but of sound  
& disposing mind & Memory, do make & Ordain this my last Will  
& Testament in manner & form following viz I bequeath  
I leave to my son William Swann five dollars & no farther  
divide of my Estate. Item I leave to my daughter Mrs J<sup>ts</sup>  
Hutchinson one feather bed & furniture & no farther divide  
of my Estate Item I leave to my son John Swann one  
Cow & one Yearling Heifer or Steer & The one third part of all  
the Sheep I now possess & no farther divide of my Estate  
Item I leave to my son Joseph Swann one young bay  
mare & the one half of the remainder of my Stock of cattle  
& Sheep & one feather bed & furniture & one half of my  
Kitchen furniture & all my plantation tools that I  
at this time possess & no farther divide of my Estate  
Item I leave to my daughter Dorcas Swann the  
plantation whereon I now live with all the appur-  
tenances thereto belonging one feather bed & furniture  
& all my household & dresser furniture & The one  
half of my Kitchen furniture & The 2 mainde of  
my Stock of cattle & Sheep. And it is my will & desire  
that my son Joseph Swann pay my son William Swann the  
five dollars left to him in this my will, & I do hereby Re-  
-vocate & appoint my two sons John Swann & Joseph Swann  
Executors of this my last Will & Testament, and I do hereby make  
& disannul all other Wills by me at any time made either by  
word or writing & pronounce this & this only to be my last Will &  
Testament, In Testimony whereof I have unto s. t my hand & seal  
This 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1802
