

In the Name of God amen I John Taylor of the County of Middlesex
 within the State of New-Jersey being in a very low state of Health at
 present but blessed be God that I am yet of sound mind &
 disposing memory. Considering the Mortality of the body so
 that it is appointed for all men even to die, do constitute & declare
 this to be my last will & Testament in manner & form following to
 first of all I give & be my spirit to God who gave it hoping
 for Mercy & acceptance in Thine Christ Jesus my Lord & my Body
 to be earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors
 hereafter named & as touching my worldly concerns I order &
 my will is that they be disposed in this manner & form following viz
 first that all my just debts & funeral charges be paid as soon as may
 be by me, executors. Then I give & be my surviving wife Mrs.
 Taylor her annual & permanent belonging to the sum of Ten pounds Sterling
 & the young man I call the painter John Butler & other furniture belonging
 to that person to be here given for me & at his disposal after my
 decease & also to be further provided for by my son John as before appre-
 hended - Then I give & be my son Abraham Taylor five
 shillings current money of New-Jersey. Then I give & be my
 to my daughter the attorney now wife to William Head five shillings
 current money as apportioned also to my son in law William Head
 the sum of five shillings current money as apportioned - Then
 I give & be my daughter Margaret now wife to Daniel
 Harton five shillings like money above to my son in law Daniel
 Harton five shillings current money as apportioned - Then I give
 divers to my son John two hundred acres of land where I now live
 including all my improvements & also all the plantations tools &
 gears & all other chattels belonging to me in said place & also
 three hundred acres of land in Tigray County in the State of New-
 Jersey also I give & be my son John after my
 death an acre & my other children receive their parts as
 mentioned in this Will, till the rest of my goods & chattels be sold for
 his own use & at his disposal for me provided there be left
 my said son John shall always take care of my ever loving
 Ruth Taylor & give her a proper & decent maintenance there
 for & let her live Hester to take care of & feed the two sons & two

this to be my last will & Testament in manner & form following to
first of all I give & bequeath my spirit to God who gave it hoping

Elizabeth her undivided Possessions belonging to the same before coming
of Mr. Young, where & to the particular parts Distress & other furniture belonging
to that estate to be her possession that has disposal after my
decease & also to be further provided for, my dear son Abraham Taylor
hereafter. Item I give & bequeath to my son Abraham Taylor five
Shillings current money of Great Britain. Also I give & bequeath
to my daughter Mary now wife to William Reed five Shillings
current money as apportioned & also to my son in law William Reed
the sum of five Shillings current money as before apportioned. Item
I give & bequeath to my Daughter Margaret now wife to Daniel
Hutton five Shillings like money also to my Son in law Daniel
Hutton five Shilling Current money as apportioned. Item I give
disire to my son John two hundred acres of land where I now live
including all my improvements & also all the plantations tools &c
goods & all other things belonging to me on said place & ~~elsewhere~~
three hundred acres of land in Virginia County in the State of North
Carolina also I give & bequeath unto my son John after my
death an equal part of my other children receive their parts as
mention'd in this Will, till the rest of my Goods & chattels be so
left in my use & at his disposal for me provided there be left
my said son John shall always take care of my ever living
son Ruth Taylor & give her a proper & decent maintenance during
her natural life & also to take care of & feed the last two & three
days to my wife apportioned. Item I give & desire to my daughter
Jane one hundred & twenty five acres of land lying in the County
Rockingham State of North Carolina bearing my son Abraham

Land, & other Bells & Goods belonging Land & also the Cows & Horses & yearlings
There were removed to my said Daughter & the more flat formerly named
Lah. & also one large pot now in the house. Also six new plates plates
of iron small besides the large one. And lastly I do constitute and
appoint my Trusty & true Servt and friend William Barnard & Robert
Brown to be my whole & sole Executrix to manage & settle my affairs
after my decease according to the true intent & meaning of this my
last will & Testament, the witness whereof they have written to my
hand & affixed my seal this 8th day of February 1777 -
Signed S. P. D. Acknowledged by the above named John Taylor
to be his last will & Testament in presence of us.

In the Name of God Amen. I Abraham Taylor being weak in body
but of perfect sound memory & judgment, and calling to mind the Mortality
of my body, that it is appointed for all men here to die, have therefore
thought fit to make this my last will & Testament, thereby revoking &
making void all other Wills & Instruments by me heretofore made
& done of whatever kind or form whatsoever. And first I recommend
my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian & decent manner at
the discretion of my Executors, and my Soul to God that gave it me
in hopes of a gracious acceptance through my Lord & Saviour Jesus
Christ. And next I will & appoint that all my Hospital Ditties be paid
them. I Will & bequeath unto Mary Taylor my loving wife her several
thirds of all my personal & moveable Estate. I also will bequeath unto
my wife during her life time this tract of land of 75 acres on which
I now live as also this other tract of land, bearing this of 125 acres which
bequeathed & left to me by my sister Jane Taylor now deceased to hold &
enjoy the said lands with all its profits & also other belonging to
the same whilst she my said wife lives upon condition that she my
said wife gives up all the right of Dowry or jointure which by law may
by her be claimed of all the rest of my land to the proper Heirs & legatees that
I may give her full title to or to cause action for them in their names
