They have a lawful claim to that is about the house. — Item I give & bequeath to my son John Todd the plantation on which I now live with all the farming utensils & other waggon & horses & cows Hogs & Sheep two lots of pasture to maintain his mother during her life. — Item It is my will that my Grandson John Todd shall have the half of the plantation on which my son James lives that lies next to Joseph Blackwood & I give him to have possession of the land when he arrives at the age of 21 years. — Item It is my will that my Grand Daughter Sarah shall have one cow. — Item It is my will that my Grand Daughter Harriet shall have one cow. — I likewise constitute my son John Todd & his wife to be my whole & sole executors of this my last will & testament. According all other wills hereby made or supposed to be made in testimony hereof there here unto set my hand this 2<sup>d</sup> day of September 1812.

Carolina in Rockingham County. Having thro' the abundant  
mercy & goodness of God in this life in body yet infirm &  
perfect understanding of memory. Do constitute this my last  
Will & Testament as follows: I give & bequeath to my beloved  
wife Rachel Farmer her choice of the bed & furniture & all her  
cloathing & cloath of every kind. with all kitchen furniture only  
what I well here after mention. Also her mare & colt & saddle  
two Cows & two sheep also 4 ewe sheep & 4 lambs & 2 hogs & 2 hens  
one year also two doves & pigs for her choice. I give & bequeath to my  
wife Rachel Farmer all the land & premises wherein I now live  
during her life & as many of the farming utensils as will be thought  
necessary for her to keep and sit her ease all the land  
moreable property to be sold & equally divided among my children  
viz Elizabeth Sibley, John Farmer, Rebecca Farmer & any  
of the young Farmer. And my son John Farmer nor his wife shall  
live on my lands to sit. my wife is to receive all the estate  
in the estate of either myself or my wife to sit in the same place to
