In the Name of God amen. I John Todd calling to mind the
Inevitability of man's death & that it is allowed to all men to mortalities
and afterwards comes the judgment. Giving my soul to God that gave
it. & my body to be decently buried at the direction of
my executors - 2^d I leave all my worldly effects to be honestly
paid - 3^d I leave my dear beloved wife Margaret Todd the one
third of all my effects at my decease. After living while she lives
off the land & to her with my son Joseph Todd. 4th I leave all the
other two thirds of my effects to my son Joseph Todd & all my
land, houses & improvements to my son Joseph Todd 5th only ten
shillings to my son William Todd it completing his full share
6th I leave ten shillings to my son James Todd it completing
his full share. 7th I leave ^{10/-} to my son Hugh Todd Deceased chil-
dren it completing their full share - 8th I leave ten shilling
to my son John Todd it completing his full share. 9th I leave
ten shillings to my son Adam Todd it completing his
full share. 10th I leave ten shillings to my daughter Polly
Todd it completing her full share, 10th I leave ten shilling
to my Daughter Hannah Lightfoot it completing her full share
11th I leave twenty shillings & six pence all other wells
as will hereafter & this to be my last Will & Testament 12th
I leave my wife Margaret Todd & my son Joseph Todd to my
widow & she recd. as witness I hereunto set my hand seal this
28th day of March 1795.

for all men once to die, do make & constitute this my last Will

of my Executors, and my worldly Estate that it has pleased
God to bless me with I dispose of in the following manner
It is my will that this plantation on which I now live, con-
taining one hundred & thirty acres be & the same is hereby
given & bequeathed to Silas Todd my grandson agreeable to my
obligation to the said Silas Todd bearing date 7th of February 1828
It is my will that the remainder of my property be sold at public
sale & the money thereby arising after paying all my debts & personal
expenses be equally divided between my surviving Heirs Viz
Duggy Todd, Ann Dunn, George Todd, James Todd, Thomas
McGinn, The Heirs of Joseph McGinn & Abby Wells, Newkirk
all, owner kills by me hand before made. It is my will that
George Todd & James Todd be my executors to this my last will
and Testament.
