 dollar, then I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas
Walker whom I likewise constitute make and
 seal up my sole Executor of this my last Will &
 Testament all & singular my lands & improvements
 & instruments, goods & chattels by him freely to be
 possessed & enjoyed; And I do hereby utterly
 disallow revoke & disannul all & every other
 former Testament, Will, Legacies & bequests and
 Executors by me in any wise before named to be
 bequeathed; Acknowledging & confirming this 8th day
 to be my last Will & Testament in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 8th May
