 ner as will best suit the convenience & advantage
 of my three sons Item It is my will & I do bequeath
 to my son James one hundred acres of land on which
 he now resides to be divided in such manner as will
 best suit the convenience & advantage of my three sons
Item It is my will that the remainder of my land which
 has not heretofore been bequeathed say two hundred
 acres be the same more or less be the property of my son
 Joseph together with one saddle horse with the saddle of
 my saddle man his saddle & bridle, one Rifle gun
 one bedstead bed & furniture - Item I do bequeath
 to my daughter Belinda one saddle horse with the saddle
 of my bay man one saddle & bridle one bedstead
 bed & furniture one cow & calf her choice of my
 stock after the choice which already have bequeathed
Item I do bequeath to my daughter Jane three cows & calves
 her choice of my stock & one bedstead bed & furniture -
