

 Share plow, two pair of Geas, I do also bequeath to my
 wife my negro woman Phoebe to be at her sole disposal
Item It is my will & I do bequeath to my son William
 one hundred & eleven acres of land on which he now resides
 to be divided from the whole of my land in such man
 ner as will best suit the convenience & advantage
 of my three sons Item It is my will & I do bequeath
 to my son James one hundred acres of land on which
 he now resides to be divided in such manner as will
 best suit the convenience & advantage of my three sons
Item It is my will that the remainder of my land which
 has not here to me been bequeathed say two hundred
 acres be the same more or less be the property of my son
Joseph together with one Saddle Horse colt the foal of
 my Saddle Mare his Saddle & Bridle one Rifle gun
 one bedstead bed & furniture Item I do bequeath
 to my daughter Melinda one Saddle horse colt the foal
