Pennsylvania the first opportunity at the cost and
charge of my Estate, he to be furnished in two suits of
clothes including the horse above mentioned & freedom
specified in his indenture unless said death and the
circumstances thereupon mentioned should happen
within one year of his freedom by law; then & in that
case I will that he receive his full freedom (the horse still
excepted) — Item I do hereby constitute & appoint my
beloved wife Elijah to the sole Execution of this my last
will & Testament all & singular my Debts & mercantile
effects to dispose of the same in form aforesaid privately
I do hereby revoke & disannul all other Wills heretofore
by me made either in word or writing; No tiffy & confirm
= ing this & no other to be my last will & Testament —
The witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
17th day July in the year of our Lord 1782

the year of our Lord 1784 I John Wilson in the County of
Chesterbearing State of Pennsylvania being very sick & weak
in body but of perfect mind & memory therefore be given unto
God therefore lett me to mind the mortaliy of my body
& knowing it is appointed for all men & women once
to die, do make & declare this my last will & Testament.

That is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of the Almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the dust from whence it came in a decent manner in the burying place of this congregation at the direction of my executors hereafter mentioned nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly estate where with it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & demise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form First of all I give & bequeath to my son James Mylie this tract of land in my possession & all implements there to belonging, likewise the Black Mare & the black Horse, likewise three Cows, two & four calves, likewise three Sheep, all the hogs on the plantation, likewise the big pot, gridle, & the kettle iron crook, pot hooks & Tongs & my own Saddle & Breast Daugh through, two Chairs & my body clothes, likewise my pecked Bible - Likewise I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Jennet Mylie the Sorrel Mare, Saddle & Bridle, the cow that carries the bell & a four year old Heifer with a white face, two Sheep, Bush & furniture & spinning wheel, likewise she is to have the charge & keeping of the aforesaid articles during life or widowhood -

Likewise I bequeath to my daughter Jane Mylie Bed & furniture likewise the Dapp Mare Saddle & Bridle, two Cows, two Sheep & some other furniture belonging to the house such as her mother thinks proper, Likewise my beloved wife is to have the charge & benefit of the aforesaid articles bequeathed to my son James Mylie until he comes of age or during her widowhood Likewise she is to have a living during life if not otherwise by Mann I likewise constatake make & order my executors Joseph Reed & Jennet Mylie of this my last will & testament & I do make utterly disallow, revoke & renounce every other former testam-
ent, legacies & bequests, & given by me in any wise before now & will & bequeath to myself performing this my

& fifty acres off the upper end of my tract of land
beginning George & ending him having to the state -
Thirty pounds good & lawful money worth ^{my} two
year old & one year old horses Item I give & bequeath
to my well beloved daughter ~~Elizabeth~~ one Roane Mere
& saddle & bridle her bed & furniture with all her
belongings Item I give & bequeath Item I give
