" In the name of God Amen, I Margaret Bowman of Meck-
 lenburg County & Province of North Carolina being weak in
 body but of sound memory blessed be God, On the 28th day of
 April in the Year of our Lord 1776 make & publish this my
 last Will & Testament in manner following that is to say
 First all my worldly goods & estate after my just debts &
 funeral charges is paid. To my three youngest Daughters
 Viz To my Daughter Rachel the one fourth of my Estate whom
 I appoint to William Henderson to be under his care until
 the coming of age, viz, on Bondage, Next to my daughter
 Margaret Bowman the one fourth of my Estate whom I appoint
 unto John Henderson to be under his care until the coming of age
 free from bondage & thirdly the remaining two fourths of my Estate
 I leave & bequeath unto my youngest daughter Martha Bowman
 whom I appoint to be given to my eldest Daughter Sarah
 Bowman & to be under her care until the coming of age free
 from bondage - And I likewise desire that my executors
 may & do give to each of my three children
