this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking & making null & void
all other wills & Testaments whatsoever by me heretofore made and
done. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
20th day of November 1806 - Signed, sealed, published, pronounced
& declared to be my last Will & Testament in presence of the under
named subscribing witnesses

 to himself into that peace & rest & incomprehensible felicity
 which he has purchased for them that love & see his Holy

 & calves, her bed & furniture. I leave four hundred dollars for the
 support of my daughter Esther to be managed at the discretion
 of my Executors; I bequeath to my three sons each of them a third
 & a wing; the balance of the House & Kitchen for return to be equally
 divided between Elizabeth & Margaret, the rest of my Estate if any
 to be equally divided among my six children. - beside I do hereby
 constitute my sons Samuel & John Green Executors of this my
