

Mecklenburg Co. NC Wills 1783-1844


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Lasting I do nominate & appoint my beloved Brother Samuel Knor to be his Special Friend Hugh Wilson sole Executor of this my last will & Testament till & singular my lands messuages & tenements to be forthwith Executed & I likewise appoint Jacobus Wilson & James Boyce as Guardians for the Children. And I do hereby disown revoke & disannul all & every other former Testaments, wills, legacies, bequests & Executors by me in my own before named will & begun a third, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 30<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord 1777  
Signed, sealed, published & pronounced by the said

John Knor as his last will & testament in presence of  
all who have hitherto subscribed thereto.

In North Carolina in Mecklenburg County. In the Name of God Amen  
The 8<sup>th</sup> day of April in the Year of our Lord 1777 I Joseph Kennedy  
of North Carolina in the County of Mecklenburg subscriber, being weak  
both & hapless body, but otherwise mind & memory thereof left to God  
therefore, calling unto mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that  
it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & declare this my  
will & Testament, that to say principally & first of all I give & recom-  
mend my soul into the hands of God that almighty & true. Then say  
I do commend to this earth to be buried a Christian & like man  
in the description & condition of my deceased nothing doubtless  
and at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by  
the mighty power of God, long as standing such worldy estate which  
with it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give & recommend  
the same in the following manner & form  
wherewithal It is my will & order that in the first place all my  
just debts to be paid & funeral charges to be paid & satisfyed  
then I will & longe wish to my beloved wife Esther Kennedy the

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plantation on ~~which~~ ~~the~~ ~~town~~ ~~has~~ ~~been~~ ~~laid~~ ~~out~~ ~~&~~ ~~which~~ ~~contains~~ ~~262~~ ~~acres~~  
 in the waters of four miles Creek during her life. I also allow  
 in the said Esther Kennedy the use of the negro wench named  
 Phillis until my son Joseph Kennedy comes to the years of  
 Twenty one. I also allow the use of the negro fellow named  
 Jerry to the said Esther Kennedy until my son David Kennedy  
 comes to the age of Twenty one. I also allow the use of the Negro  
 wench named Hannah until such time as my son Samuel  
 comes to the years of Twenty one to the said Esther Kennedy.  
 I also allow the said Esther Kennedy the use of the fourth  
 part of my personal estate, & also the fourth part of the use  
 of such real estate I shall mention here after to be sold. I also  
 allow the said Esther Kennedy the Roanoke Mare saddle & bridle  
 & bed & bed clothes, & I order the said Esther Kennedy to main-  
 tain & clothe each of my sons Joseph, David & Samuel Kennedy  
 until such times as they arrive at the age of 18 years of age  
 what learning they get till that time, but it be deducted out of  
 their patrimony the said children to be constantly kept at  
 school as their respective will admit of -

Item I will bequeath to my son Joseph Kennedy 116 acres of Land  
 upon the waters of four miles Creek & also another tract of land  
 containing 85 acres of Land adjoining to the above 116 commonly  
 known by the name of the round bottom & I also allow him to  
 get the fourth part of my personal estate & the fourth part of such  
 real estate as I shall bequeath to be sold, that is to say the fourth part  
 of what it is sold for, & I also allow him to have the negro wench  
 named Phillis when he arrives at the age of Twenty one & as  
 soon as he the said Joseph Kennedy arrives to the years of 18  
 then to be sent to the Letter School & so to continue at such learning  
 until such time as he is laborably older till the expence of his  
 education to be Roader. & out of his patrimony -

I will bequeath to my son David Kennedy two tracts of land con-  
 taining five hundred & fifty acres one of the tracts contains 350 acres  
 & the other 300 acres formerly the property of Charles Mason. I also  
 allow him to have the negro fellow named Jerry when he arrives  
 to the years of Twenty one or otherwise my executors to dispose of the

Twenty one & also to the said Esther Kennedy when she cometh  
 into the world I also allow the use of the Negro  
 servant to the age of Twenty one & also allow the use of the Negro  
 servant named Hannah until such time as my son Samuel  
 comes to the years of Twenty one to the said Esther Kennedy  
 I also allow the said Esther Kennedy the use of the fourth  
 part of my personal estate, & also the fourth part of the use  
 of such real estate I shall mention here after to be sold also  
 allow the said Esther Kennedy the Roanoke River saddle bridge  
 black bed clothes, & I order the said Esther Kennedy to main-  
 tain clothes each of my sons Joseph, David & Samuel Kennedy  
 until such times as they arrive at the age of 19 years of age  
 what learning they get till that time let it be deducted out of  
 their patrimony the said children to be constantly kept at  
 school as their expences will admit of - -  
 I will bequeath to my son Joseph Kennedy 116 acres of land  
 upon the waters of Roanoke River & also another tract of land  
 containing 85 acres of land adjoining to the above 116 consovering  
 known by the name of the round bottom & I also allow him to  
 yet the fourth part of my personal estate & the fourth part of such  
 real estate as I shall order to be sold, that is to say the fourth part  
 of what it is sold, & I also allow him to have the negro woman  
 named Phyllis when he arrives at the age of Twenty one & as  
 soon as he the said Joseph Kennedy arrives to the year of 14  
 then to be sent to the public school & so to continue at such board  
 until such time as he is laborably educated the expence there-  
 of to be deducted out of his patrimony - -  
 I will bequeath to my son David Kennedy two tracts of land con-  
 taining five hundred & fifty acres one of the tracts contains 350 acres  
 & the other 300 acres formerly the property of Charles Watson I do  
 allow him to have the negro fellow named Herow when he arrives  
 to the years of Twenty one or otherwise my executors to dispose of the  
 negro fellow & take the money & purchase a young Negro I also allow  
 the said David Kennedy to have the fourth part of my personal estate  
 & the fourth part of the money arising from such real estate as

I shall order to be sold the plantation & land to have the first child  
 the wedch Phillips has or the first child the negro wench Hannah has  
 fathered to said David I also Order the said David Kennedy to be sent  
 to the Latin School & remain at such learning untill he receives  
 liberal Education if his capacity will admit of it the expence  
 to be deducted out of his patrimony from the years of sixteen  
 I will begin with my son Samuel Kennedy one Lot in the Town of  
 Charlotte containing Six rods front & twelve rods back in the Street  
 called Trade Street bound on each side by John Sprinston & Daniel  
 Cain with the improvement of a brick house on it & other improvements  
 & as the house is not finished it is my Order that the house may be  
 finished in a decent manner & that at the expence of the Estate in  
 general I also allow my said son Samuel Kennedy to have the  
 negro wench named Hannah & against the time to the year of 21  
 & also I allow him the fourth part of my personal Estate & the fourth  
 part of the money arising from such real Estate as I shall order to  
 be sold & left on his account to the years of sixteen these to be sent to  
 the Latin School & there to remain at such learning untill he  
 receives liberal education if his capacity will admit of it  
 the expences of such Education to be deducted out of his patri-  
 mony. I also allow my son Samuel Kennedy to have the plantation  
 I now have on containing two hundred acres on the waters of one mile  
 creek whereon the mansion house stands at the death or Disease of his  
 mother Esther Kennedy & then two years of the disease of his mother  
 allowed the said Samuel Kennedy is to pay to his brother Joseph  
 Kennedy the sum of fifty pounds. Also the said Samuel Kennedy  
 is to pay the same time to his brother David Kennedy the sum  
 of fifty pounds — I also allow my executors It is my will that  
 my executors make sale of Six hundred acres land upon the  
 waters of the Catawba including the Mountain Island, Also one  
 hundred acres upon the one mile creek. Also one hundred acres  
 lying on the great road leading to Charleston within one mile  
 of Widens Ferry. Also one hundred acres on the middle fork of  
 Nine Mile & also three lots in the Town of Charlotte & all the  
 personal estate I am now possessed of The money arising from the

to be deducted out of his patrimony from the years of fourteen  
I will bequeath to my son Samuel Kennedy one Lot in the Town of  
Charlotte containing Six rods front & twelve rods back in the Street  
called Trade Street bounded on each side by John Sprinster & Daniel  
Cain with the improvement of a brick house on it & other improvements  
Had the house is not finished it is my Orders that the house may be  
finished in a decent manner & that at the expense of the Estate in  
general, I also allow my said son Samuel Kennedy to have the  
 negro Wench named Hannah against he arrives to the year of 21  
& also I allow him the fourth part of my personal Estate & the fourth  
part of the money arising from such real Estate as I shall all order to  
be sold & when he arrives to the year of fourteen then to be put to  
the Latin School & there to remain at such learning until he  
receives liberal education if his capacity will admit of it  
the expenses of such Education to be deducted out of his patri-  
mony. I also allow my son Samuel Kennedy to have the plantation  
I now have containing two hundred acres on the waters of four miles  
creek between the Mansfield House Head at the death or Disease of his  
Mother Esther Kennedy & three years of the disease of his mother  
Also said Mr Said Samuel Kennedy is to pay to his brother Joseph  
Kennedy the sum of fifty pounds, Also the said Samuel Kennedy  
is to pay the same time to his brother David Kennedy the sum  
of fifty pounds — I also allow my daughters It is my will that  
my daughters make sale of Six hundred acres land upon the  
waters of the Catawba including the man Tain Island, Also one  
hundred acres upon the two mile creek, Also one hundred acres  
lying on the great road leading to Charlotte within one mile  
of Widow Morris, Also one hundred acres on the middle fork of  
the River & also three Lots in the Town of Charlotte & all the  
personal estate I am now possessed of the money arising from the  
same to pay off any debts there is & the remainder of the money to be  
equally divided between my beloved wife Esther Kennedy &  
my three Sons Joseph & David & Samuel Kennedy the Middle  
money to be paid to them until such time as it is necessary

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for the use of the children. And it is my will that if any of my  
three sons should die without issue then his estate real & personal  
be equally divided between the other two. In the same manner  
whilst there is any of them alive provided there be no issue  
signed sealed & delivered in presence  
of us —

It is also my will that the plantation that lies in Pen  
Sylvania in Hanover Township be sold & equally divided

same manner as above directed

In the Name of God Amen. I Bidwell Klein of Mecklenburg  
County in the State of North Carolina, Planting, being mindful of the  
finiteness & mortality of human nature & that it is appointed for  
all men once to die, and considering the uncertainty of the time  
& my being weak in body, but in perfect mind ready to  
undertaking I make this my last Will & Testament in man  
ne & form followinge that is to say first I give & bequeath unto my  
my soul unto almighty God who gave it me & my body to the  
earth here to be buried according to the true Christian & my bishodres  
usage in name & certain hope that it will be raised  
ups to everlasting life at the end of the world that is to warris of our  
Lord Jesus Christ my Redemer. And as touching my worldly estate  
as it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give, bequeath, done  
& dispose of as here follows. First I give & bequeath unto my  
beloved wife Catherine one third of all my moveable Estate & also  
her bed, her spinning wheel & a few tools likewise in her best room
