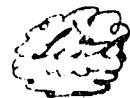

Mind & memory calling to remembrance the mortality of my body
& approaching dissolution of it; Do think it convenient to consti-
tute this to be my last will & Testament; And first I recommend my
Soul into the hand of God; and my body to the earth to be decently
interred therein at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same by the
Mighty Power of God who gave it; and as to such Temporal property
as it has pleased the Lord to bless me with, I dispose of it in the
following manner & form - I give & bequeath to my well beloved
wife Margaret Kerr the whole of every kind of worldly property
that I possess during her natural life, and to be disposed of at
her death as she may think proper - and I constitute and
appoint and make my well beloved wife Margaret Kerr &
my beloved son William Kerr to be the whole & sole Executors
of this my last will & Testament. In Testimony whereof I
