 Colarde in the County of Rockbridge Virginia being very
 sick & weak in body & knowing that it is but of perfect mind & memory -
 I desire be given unto God, therefore calling unto mind the mortality of
 my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, I do make
 & ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say principally & first of
 all, I give & recommend myself into the hands of God that gave it, & on
 my body I recommend it to the earth to be buried in a Christian like and
 decent manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but
 at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
 mighty power of God, & as concerning death worthily dispose
 of it, with pleasure God to let me in this life. I give, devise & dispose
 of the same in the following manner & form. Imprimis, it is my
 will & desire that in the first place all my last Due & funeral charges
 be paid & satisfied. ~~Then~~ I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth my beloved wife
 one bay mare called Phoebe & one donkey called Dicks together with her
 bedding & harness.
