nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God; And as touching such worldly
estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless in this life, I give, devise
& dispose of the same in the following manner & form. First I give &
bequeath the sum Twenty my dearly beloved wife to have her maintenance
out of that I am now at present, & her choice of any of the best, that
she thinks proper as long as she lives & the rest I leave to my well beloved
son Joseph Moore to take care of his mother while she is alive. Except one
pound & half & one shilling I leave to my daughter Ann Lemon, also to my
to my well beloved son to whom I likewise constitute make & order
my sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament. And I do hereby utterly
disallow, Revoke & disannul all & every other former Testament, Will,
Bequest, bequests, Executions by me in any wise before named, Willed &
bequeathed, Making & confirming this & no other to be my last Will &
Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the
day & year above written. Signed sealed published pronounced and
delivered to the said Joseph Moore as his last Will & Testament in the
presence of us the subscribers hereto present
