Rogers here living on my plantation where I now live toge-
ther with the necessary household furniture for the
benefit of raising my children except such things as may
be mentioned in this will afterwards together with my
horses & Carriage necessary to carry on the for as fast as she may
again then & in that case she is only to have a horse & saddle
her bed & furniture with all her Kitchen furniture & if
all her debts paid & she to have a Cow & Calf of her own
choise I give & bequeath to my Daughter Abigail one cow
& calf & saddle & bed & furniture & to my Daughter Martha
one Rogers & Henry Russell Rogers I give & bequeath to each
of them one Cow & calf & their Sattles & to each of them
a bed & furniture; And to my well beloved Daughter

Martha & Elizabeth, Margaret, Henry Rogers & Henry Isabella to each of them one horse & eight head of provisions & to each of them a saddle, these things to be given to be given to them when they come of age, & I give & bequeath to my two sons Joseph & John the plantation where I now live containing two hundred & 40 acres to be equally divided between them when they both come of age, notwithstanding the said to be subject to the maintenance of my two sons during their lives and also that my three youngest children be educated by the profits arising from my farm such settling as may be thought proper by my Executors — I do give & appoint my well beloved friend Moses Green & my wife to be my Executors of this my last will & Testament, & I do hereby disavow all other wills & legacies that might have been made by me & publish & pronounce this to be my last will & Testament & no other. At witness my hand this 23^d day of June 1806. — Signed in the presence of
