12th I Give & bequeath to my daughter Susannah wife of
Thomas Green five dollars to be paid out of my Estate
13th I Will & bequeath to my son James Five dollars
14th I Will & bequeath to my wife my large Bible & Psalm
book, to Thomas, Harry & Agnes each a Bible, to James
one Volume of Travels works, to Thomas one Volume of
Harveys dictionary 15th I Will & bequeath to John Sprott
Green the Revd. Blackwells Writings & to my Daughter Mary
the collections of Confession 16th I Will & appoint my wife
Catherine Executrix & James his right son Executor of

& memory I thank be to God for his mercies. To publish
this my last will & testament in manner & form as
follows. First I commend my soul to the dust to be

Executors & my Soul to God who gave it in hopes of
mercy through the Price & precious blood of Christ -

as a joint & equal property in fee simple the devise to
be subject to my wife's incipito Item I devise to my dear
& well beloved wife all my household furniture in Order
that she may be in a capacity to raise my children -
also a young boy fifty Item I devise that my Negro
servants be left under the power & direction of my exec
either to be continued on the plantation to assist in
supporting & educating my children to be hired out
from year to year & the proceeds proportioned to the best
advantage for my children, & should they so judge it
best that he be sold & the money appropriated equally
to my three children - Item I devise that the sum of
one hundred Dollars be made out of my property
that can be best spared & be kept at interest for the
use of my infant daughter - Item I devise to my dear
wife my Negro Girl Doll, also two Cows & Calves -
Sirelly I devise that all my good & Chally not
minen enumerated be disposed of join but Advan
tage for my Heirs. And I do hereby constitute my dear
wife Patsy & my Trusty Father in law & Brother in law
Samuel Harris senior & Samuel Harris junior Ex
excutors & executors of this my last will & Testament

In the name of God lesson. I John Steel of Rockbridge County & State of Virginia, being very frail in body, but reasonable in mind & memory recollecting to mind the mortality of my body, do make constatuted & declare in this my last will & testament in manner & form following America first I leave & command my soul unto Almighty God who gave it to my body to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my executors hereafter named hoping to receive the same again at the resurrection thro' the merits of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ. And as to that worldly estate that the Lord hath bestowed on me far above my desert I leave & bequeath as follows; And first I will that all my debts be speedily paid by my executors at a convenient time after my decease; And 2^d I leave unto my dearly & well beloved wife Mary her maintenance of a farm the benefit arising from the plantation as she has formerly had or enjoyed. In case her son James Thos. should have any disagreeable his shall have the full benefit of the farm with a convenient place built in it with white lace carefully lighted & he provided p wood & every thing that may render his comfortable as becomes an obedient son to a
