


to be buried in a Christian manner & have a decent

furniture I to have one bed, to have her Maintenance out of  
the estate. It is further my particular will & pleasure for my son  
Thompson to be maintained out of my estate & for my son John to  
take care of him. And Lastly I do nominate & constitute &  
appoint my Trusty friends John Hartgreen & William Wiley  
to be my whole sole executors of this my last will & testament.  
This the 21st day of February in the year of our Lord 1827

In the name of God our Father & Saviour of the world I make  
touching the province of North Carolina, being sick & weak in body but of a sound  
perfect mind & memory thinking but to God the grace of all mercy. Do make  
this my last will & testament. That is to say first of all, to commend my soul  
unto God who gave it trusting that through the merits of Jesus Christ our  
Redeemer & only Saviour I shall have a joyful & happy resurrection  
and my body I commit to the earth to be decently interred in a  
Christian like manner at the discretion of my executors herein after  
to be named. And as touching such worldly substance as it hath  
pleased you in this life to bestow me with, I do I beseech in the  
following manner - First I give my funeral expenses - Then I give to my  
loving wife Anna Hartgreen half the say aforesaid during life or  
her sojourning on the plantation where I now live & that she have  
bed & furniture over & above the third of my goods & effects which

 disposition of it amongst my fair Daughters or the survivors of them.  
 Then I give & bequeath my two plantations of Land to my two Sons John  
 & Henry Houston to be equally divided between them at the marriage  
 of either of them that shall marry first by my Executors that shall  
 be successors of that person. Then I give & bequeath to each of my  
 two Sons a Horse out of my present Stock such as my Executors shall  
 think proper. Then I give & bequeath to each of my fair Daughters  
 Frances, Lucy, Jeannett, Martha & Elizabeth one Young Cow to be  
 nominated by my Executors, Next May after the date hereof over & above  
 these several & equal shares of my goods & chattels. Then I order that  
 my two Sons herein before named John & Henry do equally pay up  
 each of my daughters wth them coming of age or Marriage the sum  
 of one hundred proclamation Money out of this Land as an Equal  
 dividend Proportion with them the said John & Henry & I do wish  
 you I desire that it is my will that my loving wife Agnes do retain under  
 his paternal care & protection my said children herein before named  
 & that they live all on & occupy the land before bequeathed during the  
 life of my said wife, for their mutual Support & Maintenance  
 & I order my Executors to School & Educate my said children in such man  
 ner as they shall think proper the expenses of which I order to be charged  
 out of the sum now, or here after to be paid out of my legacies & not of the  
 respective shares of any of them. Then I order to each of my two Sons  
 & my said one Young Cow at the time made mention of for the  
 nomination of the Cows for my daughters if my Executors shall think  
 it necessary, and as my Stock is considerable at present, I order that  
 my Executors do see that my several Legacies do take all possible  
 care thereof until the ensuing Spring & then if it is judged that the  
 same is more than my wife & children can conveniently maintain  
 that then they do by Vandue make sale there of. & the money there  
 of arising to disposition for the use of my daughters according their  
 coming to age or marriage, still observing to retain a sufficient  
 Stock on the land for the support & accommodation of my wife & children  
 & I appoint my loving wife Agnes Houston with Robert Harrison  
 & William Harris Executors of this my last will and

of either of them the Plaintiff or his Executor my Executors shall make  
be Successors of that devise. Then I give & bequeath to each of my

think fit, &c. Then I give & bequeath to each of my four Daughters  
Frances, Cherry, Jeannett, Martha & Elizabeth one Young Cow to be  
handed by my Executors next May after the date hereof over & above  
their several & equal shares of my goods & Chattels. Then I declare that  
my two Sons herein before named John & Henry do equally pay me  
each of my daughters at their coming of age or Marriage the sum  
of one hundred proclamation Money out of their Land as an Equal  
dividend Proportion with them the said John & Henry, whereupon  
then I declare that it is my will that my loving wife Agness do retain under  
her paternal care & tuition my said children herein before named  
that they live all on & occupy the land before bequeathed during the  
life of my said wife, or their mutual Support & maintenance  
then I declare my executors to sell & educate my said children in such man-  
ner as they shall think proper the expenses of which I order to be charged  
out of the common return or whole sum of my legacies & not of the  
respective shares of any of them. Then I declare to each of my two sons  
aforesaid one Young Cow at the time made mention of for the  
handomination of the same for my daughters if my Executors shall think  
it convenient, and as my Stock is considerable at present, I declare that  
my Executors do see that my several Legacies do take all possible  
care thereof until the ensuing Spring & then if it is judged that the  
same is more than my wife & children can conveniently maintain  
that then they do by Vendee make sale thereof & the money there-  
from arising to dispose of for the use of my daughters against their  
coming to age or marriage, still observing to retain a sufficient  
Stock on the land for the support & accommodation of my wife & children  
I appoint my loving wife Agness Weston with Robert Harrison  
& William Harris Esqrs my late Executors of this my last will and  
testament. Then I appoint & nominate mykinsman Col. Robert  
Harris Esqrs my Guardian of my daughters Frances, Cherry, Jeannett  
Martha & Elizabeth herein before named. & that he take Notice  
& see that the several articles herein before mentioned be

informed & that I do hereby disannul, Rescind & revoke such & void  
all, former & other Wills & Testaments by me heretofore made, in testimony  
of the said Lessees of Houston having communicated my hands & affixed  
my Seal this 14th day of August 1769 -

October 20th 1775 Lawrence Houston maturingly considering the above  
Testament as my last will do order that out of the whole of my Estate  
my Daughter Elizabeth shall have Thirtysix pounds for her support  
& at her death if any of said sum is not laid out on her account the  
remainder to equally divided among my surviving children

" In the Name of God Amen. William Henderson being weak in body but  
of perfect mind & memory understanding, Do make this my last will and  
Testament, I do leave my spirit to God that gave it, & my body to be  
decently buried at the disposal of my executors, and as for my worldly  
affairs I do positively order that all my lawful debts be paid out of  
my Estate, and the remainder as follows to wit, I leave to my loving  
wife all my plantation tools & the third of all my moveable goods &  
her cover saddle & spinning wheel. Item I leave to my sons & daughters  
namely John, Jas, Sh, William, Alexander & Jas. Henderson & my old  
now in the womb to six children above named mentioned I leave all  
my lands goods & chattels that is not mentioned before to any other  
person, Only my wife shall have the benefit of all my lands so long  
as she remains my widow, And at her death or marriage the lands shall  
be sold by my executors & equally divided with the rest of my good  
among my six children each one to have an equal part
