I Lydia Brown of County of Northumberland and
State of North Carolina being weak in body
but of sound and disposing mind and memory
do make my last will & testament in
manner & form following viz —

- 1st I will and direct that all my dust doth be
permitted to my son John Brown Jr. & he
begateth one bed bedsted & one cow holster
& sheep two fellows & sheep two sheets two double
woole winterkins that are old or worn —
2^d To my son John Brown Jr. & he begateth one
bed bedsted & one two sheets holster &
sheep two fellows & sheep his share one double
woole winterkin one quilt two coverlets and
one cow & calf —

- 4th To my son William Brown Jr. & he begateth one
bed and one bed tick. and one cow two sheets
one holster & sheep two fellows & sheep one double
woole winterkin one quilt two coverlets and
one cow & calf also my negro boy named

wishing time he willam is to syde ten hundred
dollars the part of the value of negro boy
Washington that I shall here after call to syde

5th To my son Samuel I will & bequeath one bed
one beaded & one two-shelted Bedstead & slps
two pillows pillows & slps one double wove
counterpane one quilt and two curtains also
my negro woman Ruth & her child +

6th To my son Levi I will & bequeath one bed
one bedstead & one two shelted Bedstead & slps
two pillows pillows & slps one double wove counterpane
one quilt and two curtains also two hundred
dollars that willam is to pay him out of
the price or value of negro boy Washington
7th To my only daughter Sarah J. McDowell
I will & bequeath all my riding apparel
and horses & chaises

8th I will that all my property not mentioned
above be sold at publick sale and applied
to the payment of my debts I will & direct
that it be equally divided between my son
Samuel & Levi

9th I ordain & appoint my son Beth brain and
William Sevier Executors of this my last
will & testament and by these presents
revoke a will & make void all wills by
me here after made and do leave this to
be my ^{last} will I witness whereof I have to
set my hand & seal this the 23^d day of
December 1838 under sealed &
deemed in presence of
