- Washington he will have is to pay the two hundred dollars as the part of the value of negro boy Washington that I shall here after will to pay
- 5th To my son Samuel I will & bequeath one bed one bedstead & cover two sheets Bolster & shp two pillows pillows & shps one double cover counterpane one quilt and two coverlets also two hundred dollars that William is to pay him out of the price or value of negro boy Washington
- 6th To my son Leafe I will & bequeath one bed one bedstead & cover two sheets Bolster & shp two pillows & shps one double cover counterpane one quilt and two coverlets also two hundred dollars that William is to pay him out of the price or value of negro boy Washington
- 7th To my only daughter Nancy of McDowell I will & bequeath all my wearing apparel and shoes & changes
- 8th I will that all my property not willed above be sold at public sale and a payoff to the payment of my debts I will & desire that it be equally divided between my son Samuel & Jesse
- 9th I do give & appoint my son Bath Samuel and William Exors of this my last will & testament and by these presents revoke & make void all wills by me her after made and declare this to be my ^{last} will I write where of above to set my hand & seal this the 23rd day of December 1838 Signed sealed &
