Item 1st It is my will & pleasure that all my last debts be paid -
Item 2nd I bequeath to my step daughter Mary Barr my silver & gold
like was a ring & some other things -

Item 3rd I bequeath to my daughter Mary Giddens my negro
girl Sarah & her bed & furniture -

Item 4th I bequeath to my son James Barr my negro girl Peggy
and likewise a bed & furniture -

Item 5th The residue of my property to be sold to the highest bidder
I appoint John Wilson & John C. Barr Executors
of this my last will & testament in testimony
of my hand and seal this 14th September 1852
