3rd It is my will that all my ~~movable~~ household
 & kitchen furniture to gether with all my
 stock on interest in the tract of water
 & logs and my farming tools be equally divided
 between my two sons Robert C. Barnett & son
 Abel Barnett. I do desire my family pay
 each of my daughters (Wife) Elizabeth the first
Sarah Darnley Erskine. This sum of ten
 dollars each within one year from my death.

4th It is my will that my great debts ~~debts~~
 & personal expenses be discharged by my
 two sons Robert C. Barnett & son Abel Barnett
 and my share of the present cost on hand
 be equally divided between said two sons.

 & ~~John~~ Barnes my Executors to execute this
 my last will & testament in witness where

 seal this 19th day of January 1864

 & one silver pencil then I will to my daughter
 to my daughter Martha one set silver spoons
 then I will to my daughter Emily one
 set silver spoons all the remainder
