testament thereby abiding and superseding
all former wills by me made) in manner
as follows:

1st Commending my soul to god who gave
it and my body to be decently interred
by my friends in hope of a blessed life
Resurrection to life everlasting Amen.

I st^d will & bequeath to my son Robert C. Barnett
my horse bld & all feed to gother with
feathers bed & furniture
Item I will and bequeath to my son Abel
Barnett Negro man London to gother with
a note I hold on him given for my interest
in a tract of land

Item it is my will that all my other household
& Belonging furniture together with all my
Stock or interests in the stock of Cattle
& Hogs and my farming tools be equally divided
between my two sons Robert C. Barnett & Abel
Abel Barnett - Conditioned they shall pay
back of my debts \$1000 Elizabeth the last
Same Date January 1850 the sum of ten
dollars besides within one year from my death

Item it is my will that my just debts demands
& personal expenses be discharged by my
two sons Robert C. Barnett & Abel Barnett
and my share of the present cotton land
be equally divided between said two sons

lately I have made & appoint Little, Barnes
 & Clark Barnes my executors to execute this
 my last will & testament in witness where
 of I have this day set my hand and affix my
 seal this 17th day of January 1834
 done & sealed & delivered in
 presence of us - Margaret ^{my daughter}

 divine Providence has favoured me with in
 the form & manner following to wit - —
 It is my will after just debts & funeral
 charges paid out of my Estate
 Item to my mother Martha weather by her
 own or family dollars worth of land held
 sometime at her own disposal and one bay
 mare named Jenny & one white cow
 & calf to be here while she keeps my three
 children whom I bequeath to my sister Anna
 Weather one fine calver quit them I will
 to my daughter Margaret one shall come
 from silver plates these I will to my daughter
 to my daughter Martha one set silver plates
 them I will to my daughter Emily one
 set silver plates etc the remainder
