

Now I declare that after the death of my wife Peggy the plantation on which I live be divided between my son Isaac and my Daughter Peggy as follows viz by my Spring branch from James tree line to the highest corner of said branch thence continuing a right line directed by the general course of that branch untill it strikes James Wilsons line, that all the land lying on the South side of said line be the property of Isaac his Heirs & assigns forever; and that the land lying on the North side of said line be the property of my Daughter Peggy during her natural life & after her decease to descend in fee simple to said Peggys son Alexander Campbell Miller

Item I declare that every species of property whether Real or personal that shall remain at my wifes death & not finally disposed of by any preceding clause be put to fair open sale & that the proceeds of the same be equally divided between my two children Isaac & Peggy -

Finally I do hereby constitute & appoint my true & trusty friends Nathaniel Alexander & James Wilson Esq the Executors of this my last will & Testament

In witness I will, give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Rachel Sharpe

one negro child called Dorcas -
 Item I give & bequeath to my beloved son Theophilus Cannon one negro man called
 Caesar & one feather bed & furniture -
 Item I give & bequeath to my beloved son Joseph Cannon one negro boy called
 Charles & one feather bed and furniture -
 Item I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Margaret Sharpe one
 negro woman called Dina & my own old feather bed & furniture
 To them & their Heirs for ever -
 Item I give all my wearing Clothes to my said two Daughters -
 Equally between them -
 And whereas my said son Joseph has sustained a loss by staying &
 waiting on me this winter in my affliction &c and in order
 that he may have full compensation - Item I will & order
 my Executors of this will to allow him such a sum as they
 in their discretion shall judge to be equitable & proper to
 be paid him out of my Estate -
 Item I also allow & order said Executors to allow Anna Cannon such
 a compensation or sum for her constant care & nursing me in
 my affliction as they may in prudence judge equitable & right
 to be paid out of my Estate -
 I also request & order my said Executors to sell at public sale or
 otherwise as they may judge fit & suitable all the remainder of my
 Estate and after paying all my just Debt & necessary charges & the
 above two Allowances, that then the net residue shall be divided
 equally share & share alike between my said sons Theophilus
 & Joseph -
 And Lastly I hereby nominate my friends William Bancroft &
 Joseph McNeill & Alexander to be my whole & sole Executors of this
 my last will & Testament, Resolving all others; & confirming
 this to be my last will & Testament; In witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 20th day of October
 1802 -
