to be enjoyed by them in full possession at the death of my
wife Joseph Foster & James, & Co. I constitute & appoint
Executors of this my last will & Testament, and I do hereby
direct & Revise & disannul all former other former
Wills, Testaments, Legacies Bequests Executors by me in any way
before named, made & so, method, Ratifying & confirming
this, & no other to be my last will & Testament. In witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year first

sum of One thousand. It is my will & pleasure that the remainder
of my Estate if any there be, be divided among my surviving
brothers & sisters — and first I do appoint Capt James Stevens
James Stevens, Andrew Elliott my sole executors of this
my last will & Testament, Reserving all former wills, gifts
or bequests made by me made or given, confirming this bid no
other to be my last will & Testament. The witness whereof I have
set my hand & affixed my seal this 10th day of July 1801
