that is to say principally & first of all I give my soul
into the hands of God that gave it, & my body I
recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent man-
ner at the discretion of my Executors, but as touching
such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow
on me with in this life I give & dispose of thus come
in the manner & form Viz I give & bequeath to my
beloved son Jesse Jackson two dollars if he comes
to receive it in the space of two years if not to fall
to my Grand Niece Margret Wallen, I give and
bequeath to my Grand Niece Margret Wallen
two half Soles & Three Guineas & a half one Maiden
also my best & prettiest & all my body clothes &
also a pewter four dishes & three basons & half dozen of spoons
four knives & forks, one chest, one spinning wheel & wift
one Gold ring & silver clasps & Bow iron & one pett & books
& clock & one Needle & one gridle. And I hereby
nominate & appoint William Wallen and
Matthew Wallen to be my sole Executors of this my
last will & Testament, And I do hereby revoke and
disannul all & every other former wills Testa-
ments, Legacies & Executors by me in anywise made
willed or bequeathed before, And I do certify this
& no other to be my last will & Testament. In wit-
ness whereof I the said Charles Wilson have hereunto

set my hand & seal this 8th day of June 1814 -
