all others & pronouncing them null & void.

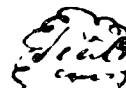

& my Executors hereafter mentioned who I doubt not will manage it

God to bless me with, I will & order that my just debts & funeral expenses
be first paid & the remainder to be disposed of as follows. I give
& give I bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Hazines one hundred
dollars & the said wife & three cows her choice of the stock & negro Friday
Leaving her widowed & at her marriage or death to be the pro-
perty of my beloved son John Hazines which negro I leave to support
my family while they live together to support & make gain for them
& her one bed & furniture to her my said wife & one negro girl
named Indat while she my said wife lives single & then when her
the above mentioned follows to be sold as the Legislature shall direct
the money arising from such sale to be equally divided among
my three sons, Joseph Hazines, William Hazines & John Hazines & the
